10                   COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

11                   An Act relating to torts; permitting liability for  
12 damages committed by a trespasser; authorizing  
13 vicarious liability for person or entity that  
14 compensates trespasser; providing for codification;  
15 and providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18                   SECTION 1.           NEW LAW           A new section of law to be codified  
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 80.1 of Title 76, unless there  
20 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21                   A. A person who is arrested or convicted of trespass may be  
22 held liable for any damages to personal or real property while  
23 trespassing.

1       B. A person or entity that compensates or remunerates a person  
2 for trespassing as described in subsection A of this section, may  
3 also be held vicariously liable for any damages to personal or real  
4 property committed by the person compensated or remunerated for  
5 trespassing.

6       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
