9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to roads and bridges; designating the
11 Jennifer Lea Briggs and Heather Wilson Memorial
12 Highway; designating the Keith Alan Copeland Memorial
13 Bridge; requiring placement of certain permanent
14 markers; providing for codification; and providing an
15 effective date.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.250 of Title 69, unless
19 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 The portion of State Highway 33 in Payne County beginning at the
21 Cimarron River in southwest Payne County and extending east to the
22 junction of State Highway 33 and U.S. Highway 177 shall be
23 designated as the "Jennifer Lea Briggs and Heather Wilson Memorial
24 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.251 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge over Interstate 35 on Historic Route 66 in northern Oklahoma County shall be designated as the "Keith Alan Copeland Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the bridge.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
