AMENDATORY 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 11-1208. A. When overtaking and passing a bicycle 18 proceeding in the same direction, a person driving a motor vehicle 19 on a two-lane road with one lane designated for travel in each 20 direction shall exercise due care by leaving a lateral safe distance 21 between the motor vehicle and the bicycle of not less than three (3) 22 five (5) feet until the motor vehicle is safely past the overtaken 23 bicycle. 24

1	B. When overtaking and passing a bicycle proceeding in the same
2	direction, a person driving a motor vehicle on a multi-land road
3	with two or more lanes designated for travel in each direction shall
4	exercise due care by moving completely over to the adjacent lane
5	until the motor vehicle is safely past the overtaken bicycle.
6	$\underline{\text{C.}}$ If a person violates the provisions of subsection A $\underline{\text{or B}}$ of
7	this section and the violation results in a collision, crash or fall
8	causing <del>serious</del> physical injury to another person, the person shall
9	be subject to a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00)
10	One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).
11	$\frac{C.}{D.}$ If a person violates the provisions of subsection A $\underline{\text{or B}}$
12	of this section and the violation results in the death of another
13	person, the person shall be subject to a fine of not more than <del>One</del>
14	Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), in
15	addition to any other penalties prescribed by law.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
