8                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9           An Act relating to counties and county officers;  
10          amending 19 O.S. 2011, Section 517.1, as amended by  
11          Section 1, Chapter 299, O.S.L. 2014 (19 O.S. Supp.  
12          2016, Section 517.1), which relates to departmental  
13          records; providing time period that certain  
14          recordings from equipment attached to law enforcement  
15          officers shall be kept; and providing an effective  
16          date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18           SECTION 1.           AMENDATORY           19 O.S. 2011, Section 517.1, as  
19          amended by Section 1, Chapter 299, O.S.L. 2014 (19 O.S. Supp. 2016,  
20          Section 517.1), is amended to read as follows:

21           Section 517.1 A. The governing body of each county may  
22          establish a length of time for the county to keep departmental  
23          records and authorize the sheriff to properly dispose of or convert  
24          to microfilm or a similar medium all records not specifically  
25          addressed in other statutes. ~~Such~~

1        B. Except as otherwise provided in this section, records shall  
2 be kept for a minimum of seven (7) years; ~~provided, however.~~  
3 However, if the sheriff is the sole source for such records, the  
4 records shall be kept for a minimum of seven (7) years; ~~provided,~~  
5 that any audio or video recordings from recording equipment attached  
6 to the person of a law enforcement officer that depict anything  
7 other than an officer-involved shooting, use of lethal force,  
8 incidents involving medical treatment, incidents where a written  
9 application is received for the preservation of the specific event,  
10 or upon request of the district attorney may be kept at a minimum of  
11 thirty (30) days and no more than one hundred eighty (180) days to  
12 be determined by the county sheriff.

13        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
