10	An Act relating to schools; amending Section 1,
11	Chapter 222, O.S.L. 2017 (70 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 13-116), which relates to punishment for students
12	with disabilities; prohibiting the use of seclusion on students identified with the most significant
13	cognitive disabilities; providing exception for written consent; defining term; and providing an
14	effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 222, O.S.L.
18	2017 (70 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 13-116), is amended to read as
19	follows:
20	Section 13-116. A. School district personnel shall be
21	prohibited from using corporal punishment or seclusion on students
22	identified with the most significant cognitive disabilities
23	according to criteria established by the State Department of
24	Education unless addressed in an annual individualized education

1	program (IEP) developed in accordance with the Individuals with
2	Disabilities Education Act (IDEA).
3	B. A waiver to the provisions of subsection A of this section
4	shall be granted if the parent or legal guardian of a student
5	provides written consent.
6	C. As used in this section $_{ au :}$
7	1. "corporal Corporal punishment" means the deliberate
8	infliction of physical pain by hitting, paddling, spanking, slapping
9	or any other physical force used as a means of discipline; and
10	2. "Seclusion" means involuntary confinement alone in a room or
11	area where the student is physically prevented from leaving, usually
12	because the door or exit is locked or obstructed.
13	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
