NEW LAW 15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1925.5 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 16 17 Beginning July 1, 2021, an assisted living center, as 18 defined in paragraph 1 of Section 1-890.2 of Title 63 of the 19 Oklahoma Statutes, shall be required to have at least ninety-six 20 (96) hours of alternate sources of energy sufficient to maintain 21 facility temperatures through the operation of existing heat and air 22 conditioning systems to protect resident health and safety and for 23 the safe and sanitary storage of food, medicines and other necessary

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provisions.

1	B. Notwithstanding anything in subsection A to the contrary, an
2	assisted living center newly licensed beginning November 1, 2018,
3	shall be required to meet the requirements contained in subsection A
4	upon licensure.
5	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
