AMENDATORY 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 1335. Whoever, having been admitted to bail for 18 appearance before any district court in the State of Oklahoma, (1) 19 incurs a forfeiture of the bail and willfully fails to surrender 20 himself or herself within thirty (30) days following the date of 21 such forfeiture, or (2) willfully fails to comply with the terms of 22 his or her personal recognizance, shall be guilty of a felony and 23 shall be fined not more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or 24 imprisoned not more than two (2) years, or both; provided, that if

1	the person used the services of a bail bondsman for the bail for
2	which was the subject of the violation of the provisions of this
3	section, charges shall be filed upon request by the bail bondsman
4	within thirty (30) days of the request. Failure to timely file the
5	charges as provided in this section shall exonerate the bond by
6	operation of law.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
