AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 6-110.3, as 19 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 376, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 20 2017, Section 6-110.3), is amended to read as follows: 21 Section 6-110.3 A. The Legislature finds that the enactment 22 into law by the United States Congress of the federal REAL ID Act of 23 2005, Public Law Number 109-13, is an action that individual 24 Oklahomans should have an option to refuse under the principles of

- 1 federalism contained in the Tenth Amendment to the United States Constitution.
- 3 В. The State of Oklahoma shall offer its citizens the option of choosing a Compliant Driver License or Identification Card or a Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card.
 - In carrying out the provisions of this Act act, the State of Oklahoma shall not share with the federal government any personal information or biometric data obtained from an applicant for an Oklahoma REAL ID compliant Compliant or noncompliant driver license Noncompliant Driver License or identification card Identification Card except as required by the REAL ID Act of 2005, Public Law Number 109-13. Provided, this subsection shall not prevent the sharing of such information between agencies, boards, commissions or political subdivisions of this state or as otherwise permitted by law.
 - D. The Department of Public Safety shall be required to provide notice to applicants for an Oklahoma REAL ID Compliant or Noncompliant Driver License or Identification Card of its use of facial recognition hardware or software and the purposes for which it is being used.

- 23 Facial feature pattern characteristics recognition hardware 24 or software;
