7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to pediatric cancer; requiring
9 diagnosis of pediatric cancer to be reported based on
10 child's legal address; providing for codification;
11 and providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-559.2d of Title 63, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 When a child under the age of eighteen (18) years of age is
17 diagnosed with a form of pediatric cancer, the diagnosis shall be
18 reported as having occurred based on the child's current legal
19 address. The diagnosis shall not be reported as having occurred
20 based on the location of the physician who made such diagnosis.

21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
