8 An Act relating to definitions and general
9 provisions; designating the red-tailed hawk as the
10 state raptor; providing for codification; and
11 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.17 of Title 25, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The red-tailed hawk, *Buteo jamaicensis*, is hereby designated and
18 adopted as the state raptor of the State of Oklahoma.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
