11 An Act relating to state employees; providing maximum
12 salary amount for certain employees; providing
13 exceptions; providing for codification; and providing
14 an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 840-2.15C of Title 74, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Effective November 1, 2018, and for each fiscal year
20 thereafter, no state employee shall receive a salary which is
21 greater than ninety percent (90%) of the salary paid to the chief
22 executive officer of the agency, board, commission, department or
23 program in the executive branch of state government by which the
24 employee is employed.

1 B. The provisions of this section shall not apply to physicians
2 licensed by the State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision or
3 the State Board of Osteopathic Examiners, veterinarians,
4 psychologists, speech pathologists, registered nurses, advanced
5 practice registered nurses, PhDs in the medical field, dentists,
6 optometrists and other licensed medical professionals.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
