| 21 | 1. "Pharmacogenomics" means the study of how genetic factors |

- B. Every person who requires a prescription for a behavioral medication such as antidepressants, bipolar and antipsychotics or is taking four or more drugs may have a pharmacogenomics profile conducted and recorded in the person's medical record.
- C. A pharmacogenomics profile shall include the results of at least eighteen genes tested and be accompanied by treatment guidance for each disease state-tested. Each person having such a test shall be entitled to receive a copy of the results or to view them in the medical record.
- D. Any behavioral health services provided shall be in accordance with a comprehensive assessment and the person's pharmacogenomics profile.
- E. The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules as necessary to implement the requirements of this section.
- 18 | SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
