AMENDATORY 12 O.S. 2011, Section 1148.5A, is 16 amended to read as follows: 17 Section 1148.5A If, in the exercise of reasonable diligence, 18 service cannot be made upon the defendant personally nor upon any 19 person residing upon the premises over fifteen (15) years of age, 20 then in lieu of service by certified mail, service may be obtained 21 for the sole purpose of adjudicating the right to restitution of the 22 premises by the sheriff's posting or by private process service 23 posting of said summons conspicuously on the building on the 24 premises, and, if there be no building on said premises, then by

1	posting the same at some conspicuous place on the premises sought to
2	be recovered at least five (5) days prior to the date of trial, and
3	by the claimant's mailing a copy of said summons to the defendant at
4	his last-known address of the defendant by certified mail at least
5	five (5) days prior to said date of trial. Such service shall
6	confer no jurisdiction upon the court to render any judgment against
7	the defendant for the payment of money nor for any relief other than
8	the restoration of possession of the premises to the claimant,
9	unless the defendant appears at trial. If the court only renders a
10	judgment for restoration of possession of the premises, the claimant
11	shall not be precluded from pursuing a subsequent action for the
12	payment of rent or any other monetary relief. Such service shall
13	not be rendered ineffectual by the failure of the defendant to
14	actually see or receive such posted process nor by his <u>the</u> failure
15	of the defendant to actually receive or sign a return receipt for
16	such mailed process.
17	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
