7                               AS INTRODUCED

8           An Act relating to ethics; prohibiting use of certain  
9           state property for personal political advocacy;  
10          providing for penalties; and providing an effective  
11          date.

13   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
15   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4263 of Title 74, unless there  
16   is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17           A.   No state officer or employee shall use a state-owned  
18   telephone, state electronic mail or other state equipment, property  
19   or services for personal political advocacy. Violations of this  
20   section shall be reported to the Ethics Commission.

21           B.   Any state officer or employee that has been determined by  
22   the Ethics Commission to have violated this section shall result in  
23   a warning for the first offense, a civil penalty of not more than  
24   One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for the second offense and a civil

1 penalty of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the third  
2 offense. Any subsequent offenses shall be grounds for termination  
3 of employment.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
