NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.9 of Title 63, unless 20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 21 Each assisted living center shall annually provide to each 22 of its residents, no later than September 1 of each year, 23 educational information on influenza disease. Such information 24 shall include, but not be limited to:

- 1 1. The risks associated with influenza disease;
 - 2. The availability, effectiveness and known contraindications of the influenza immunization;
 - 3. Causes and symptoms of influenza; and
 - 4. The means by which influenza is spread.
 - B. Making available the appropriate and current Vaccine
 Information Statement as provided by the Centers for Disease Control
 and Prevention shall be deemed compliant with the requirements
 contained in subsection A of this section.
 - C. Nothing in this section shall be construed to require an assisted living center to provide or pay for any vaccination against influenza for its residents.
 - D. No person shall have a cause of action for any loss or damage caused by any act or omission resulting from providing or the lack of providing educational information required by subsection A of this section.
 - E. The license of the assisted living center shall not be affected due to the providing or lack of providing the educational information required by subsection A of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
