7                               AS INTRODUCED

8           An Act relating to public health and safety;  
9           requiring State Department of Health to promulgate  
10          certain rules; providing for codification; and  
11          providing an effective date.

12   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13           SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
14   in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-546.6 of Title 63, unless  
15   there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16           The State Department of Health shall promulgate rules that  
17   require pregnant women who are prescribed opiates for greater than  
18   five (5) days to receive pain management services.

19           SECTION 2.   This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
