14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1135.9 of Title 47, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is authorized to enter into a
19 contract with a private vendor experienced in the marketing and sale
20 of:

21 1. Personalized license plates authorized under Section 1135.4
22 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

23 2. Special license plates authorized under Sections 1135.3,
24 1135.5 and 1135.7 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

1 B. 1. The Commission shall establish by rule administrative
2 fees for license plates issued and renewed under the provisions of
3 subsection A of this section. The administrative fees authorized by
4 this paragraph shall be reasonable but not less than the amounts
5 necessary for the Commission to recover costs to the Commission
6 associated with the:

- 7 a. awarding of the contract authorized by this section,
- 8 b. implementation and enforcement of such contract, and
- 9 c. direct and indirect administrative costs associated
10 with administering the provisions of this section.

11 2. The fees authorized by this subsection shall be in addition
12 to all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle
13 License and Registration Act, including the fees required by
14 Sections 1135.3, 1135.4, 1135.5 and 1135.7 of Title 47 of the
15 Oklahoma Statutes.

16 C. The contracted amount payable to a private vendor related to
17 the marketing and sale of special license plates shall only be
18 payable from amounts derived from administrative fees associated
19 with the issuance and renewal of such personalized and special
20 license plates.

21 D. 1. The Commission may approve additional designs and color
22 combinations for personalized and special license plates authorized
23 under the provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes, including
24 for special license plates that may be personalized, that may be

1 marketed and sold by a private vendor under a contract entered into
2 under the provisions of this section. Each approved license plate
3 design and color combination shall remain the property of the
4 Commission.

5 2. This subsection shall not be interpreted to authorize:

6 a. the Commission to approve a design or color
7 combination for a specialty license plate, or

8 b. the private vendor to market or sell a special license
9 plate with a design or color combination,

10 that is inconsistent with the design or color combination specified
11 for the license plate in the special license plate's authorizing
12 statute.

13 E. The Commission shall not:

14 1. Restrict the background color, color combinations or color
15 alphanumeric license plate numbers of a special license plate,
16 except as determined by the Department of Public Safety as necessary
17 for law enforcement purposes;

18 2. Restrict the private vendor from conducting reasonable
19 events or auctions;

20 3. Restrict the right of the private vendor to offer a variety
21 of plate categories with both personalized and nonpersonalized
22 patterns; or

23 4. Unreasonably disapprove or limit the ability for the private
24 vendor to offer plate terms that exceed one (1) year.

1 F. The Commission may cancel a license plate or require the
2 discontinuation or redesign of a license plate design or color
3 combination that is marketed and sold by a private vendor under
4 contract at any time if the Commission determines that the
5 cancellation or discontinuation is in the best interest of the state
6 or the motoring public.

7 G. To the extent fees collected under the provisions of this
8 section are in excess of the total amounts provided in subparagraphs
9 a, b and c of paragraph 1 of subsection B of this section and other
10 apportionment provisions for personalized or specialized license
11 plates, the excess amount shall be deposited to the credit of the
12 General Revenue Fund.

13 H. 1. A contract entered into with a private vendor under the
14 provisions of this section shall provide for the Commission to
15 recover all costs incurred by the Commission in implementing the
16 provisions of this section. Under the provisions of the contract,
17 the Commission may require the private vendor to reimburse the
18 Commission in advance for:

- 19 a. not more than one-half (1/2) of the Commission's
20 anticipated costs in initiating the contract, and
- 21 b. the Commission's anticipated costs in coordinating the
22 introduction of a new special license plate.

23 2. The initial term of contract entered into under the
24 provisions of this section shall be no less than five (5) years in

1 duration. Such contract may provide for additional terms at least
2 equal in length to the initial term of the contract.

3 I. As applied to contracts entered under the provisions of this
4 section, the Commission shall not:

5 1. Unreasonably disapprove or limit any aspect of a private
6 vendor's marketing and sales plan; or

7 2. Unreasonably interfere with the selection, assignment or
8 management by the private vendor of the private vendor's employees,
9 agents or subcontractors.

10 J. A private vendor shall not market and sell license plates
11 that compete directly for sales with other special license plates
12 issued under the provisions of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes,
13 unless the Commission and the agency or organization associated with
14 the special license plate authorizes such marketing and sale.

15 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
16 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
17 2017, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

18 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
19 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
20 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
21 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
22 subject as provided by this section.

23 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
24 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of

1 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
2 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
3 registered for the current year.

4 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
5 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
6 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

7 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
8 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
9 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
10 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
11 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

12 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
13 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
14 applications for special license plates authorized under this
15 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
16 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
17 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
18 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
19 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
20 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
21 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
22 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
23 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
2 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
3 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
4 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
5 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
6 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
7 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
8 removed from the vehicle.

9 Except as otherwise provided in ~~this section~~ law, for special
10 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special
11 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
12 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
13 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
14 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
15 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
16 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
17 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
18 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

19 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
20 follows:

21 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 round and square dancing;
24

1 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
2 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
3 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

5 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
6 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
7 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
9 Association;

10 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be
11 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
12 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
13 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
14 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
15 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
16 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
17 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
19 contain the Masonic emblem;

20 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
21 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
22 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
24 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in

1 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
2 contain the Shriner's emblem;

3 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
5 ballooning in this state;

6 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
8 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
9 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
10 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
11 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an
12 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
13 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
14 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
15 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

16 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
18 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
19 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
20 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
21 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
22 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
23 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
24

1 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
2 Columbus emblem;

3 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
4 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
5 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

7 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
9 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
10 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
11 consultation with Kiwanis International;

12 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
14 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
15 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
16 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
17 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
18 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
19 Accountants;

20 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
22 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
23 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
24 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,

1 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
2 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
3 emergency management department head;

4 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
5 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
7 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
8 Conservation Corps;

9 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
10 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
11 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license
12 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
13 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
14 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
15 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
17 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

18 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such
19 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
20 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
21 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
22 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

23 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

1 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
2 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
3 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
4 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

5 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
7 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
8 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
9 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
10 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
11 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
12 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
13 personalized license plates;

14 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
15 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
16 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
17 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
18 consultation with American Business Clubs;

19 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates
20 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
21 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
22 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
23 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
24 Oklahoma;

1 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
3 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
4 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

5 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
6 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
7 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be
8 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

9 22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such
10 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
11 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
12 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

13 23. Parrothead Club License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
15 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
17 for personalized license plates;

18 24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates
19 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
20 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
21 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

22 25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
24 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed

1 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
2 Association;

3 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
5 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
7 Sorority;

8 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
9 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
10 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and
11 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
12 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
13 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
14 Incorporated;

15 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
17 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
19 of Health;

20 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
21 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
22 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
23 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
24 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

1 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
2 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
3 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
4 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
5 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of
6 America Incorporated;

7 31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
9 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
10 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority
11 Incorporated;

12 32. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
13 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi
14 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

16 33. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha
18 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
19 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity
20 Incorporated;

21 34. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
22 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
23 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System
24 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation

1 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
2 Officials;

3 35. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
5 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
6 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity
7 Incorporated;

8 36. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be
9 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho
10 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
11 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.
12 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma
13 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,
14 2013;

15 37. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be
16 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
17 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates
18 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
19 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

20 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates
21 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
23 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
24 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

1 39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support for the United States Air Force Academy;

4 40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
6 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

7 41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
11 Weather Center Directors;

12 42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
15 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish
16 Foundation;

17 43. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such
18 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
19 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.
20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South
21 Central Section PGA Foundation;

22 44. Putnam City High School License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
24 for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed in

1 consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School Alumni
2 Association, Inc.;

3 45. Autism Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
5 autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
6 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

7 46. Oklahoma Blood Institute License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall be
10 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Blood Institute;

11 47. Zeta Phi Beta and Phi Beta Sigma License Plate - such
12 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of
13 Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The license
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapters
15 of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity
16 Incorporated;

17 48. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
19 for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates
20 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
21 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions
22 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School
23 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

1 49. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
5 School Alumni Association;

6 50. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
7 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
9 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with
10 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
11 Association;

12 51. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
13 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music
14 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,
15 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
16 the Greenwood Cultural Center;

17 52. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
19 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be
20 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle
21 Association;

22 53. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
24

1 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization;

3 54. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
4 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
5 of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

7 55. BMW Car Club of America License Plate - such plates shall
8 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
9 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any
10 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a
11 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
12 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of
13 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of
14 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License
15 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

16 56. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem
18 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
19 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
20 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

21 57. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
22 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
23 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
24

1 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
2 Arts;

3 58. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
7 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
8 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

9 59. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

13 60. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
15 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
16 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

17 61. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
19 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

21 62. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
23 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
24 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

1 63. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
4 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
5 District;

6 64. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
7 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
8 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
9 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
10 Alumni Association;

11 65. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
13 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
14 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

16 66. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
18 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
19 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
20 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall
21 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
22 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject
23 to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma
24

1 Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective
2 November 1, 2015;

3 67. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
5 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
6 Tulsa 66ers Organization;

7 68. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
8 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
9 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
10 representatives of the Frederick School District;

11 69. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
12 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
13 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current
14 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
15 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

16 70. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be
17 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
18 Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the
19 Oklahoma Fosters Initiative; and

20 71. Red Dirt Jeeps - such plates shall be designed and issued
21 to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Red Dirt Jeeps and
22 such plates shall be designed in consultation with Red Dirt Jeeps,
23 L.L.C.

24

1 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
2 per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
3 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
4 Registration Act. Unless otherwise provided in this section, the
5 fee shall be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year
6 of renewal of the special license plate fee shall be deposited in
7 the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
8 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act
9 and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) per year of renewal of the
10 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in

12 SECTION 3. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.4, is
13 amended to read as follows:

16 personalized license plates shall be issued on a staggered system
17 except for vintage decals.

18 Personalized special license plates shall not be transferred to
19 any other person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer
20 of ownership and retained. The personalized special license plate
21 may then be used on another vehicle but only after such other
22 vehicle has been registered for the current year.

23 Personalized special license plates shall be renewed each year
24 by the Tax Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by

1 the Tax Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1)
2 year. The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons
3 issued special license plates. The notice shall contain all
4 necessary information and shall contain instructions for the renewal
5 procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax
6 Commission. The motor license agent fees for renewals shall be paid
7 out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

8 B. Such plates shall be designed and issued for the following:

9 1. Any person in any combination of numbers or letters from one
10 to a maximum of seven;

11 2. Persons eligible for two or more of the military decoration
12 special license plates provided for in ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma~~
13 ~~Statutes~~ this title. Such plates may be issued in any combination
14 of emblems. However, such plates shall only display up to three
15 emblems and shall also display any combination of letters or numbers
16 from one to a maximum of three;

17 3. Motorcycles in any combination of numbers or letters from
18 one to a maximum of six;

19 4. Persons eligible for Korean War Veteran license plates
20 provided for in ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title. Such
21 plates may display any combination of letters or numbers up to three
22 on each side of the insignia or emblem;

23 5. Persons eligible for World War II Veteran license plates
24 provided for in ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title. Such

1 plates may display any combination of letters or numbers up to three
2 on each side of the insignia or emblem; and

3 6. Persons owning vehicles which are twenty-one (21) years and
4 older are qualified to submit for approval by the Tax Commission or
5 a motor license agent a vintage but expired official Oklahoma
6 license plate which is twenty-one (21) years and older. Upon
7 approval of such personalized plate, the owner shall be issued the
8 annual registration decal which the Tax Commission or agent shall
9 direct to be affixed.

10 C. The fee for such plates shall be Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per
11 year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other registration
12 fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.
13 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the personalized tag
14 fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement
15 Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle
16 License and Registration Act. Twelve Dollars (\$12.00) per year of
17 renewal of the personalized tag fee shall be apportioned as provided
18 in Section 1104 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

19 SECTION 4. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
20 last amended by Section 3, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
21 2017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

22 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
23 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
24

1 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
2 financial assistance as provided by this section.

3 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
4 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
5 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
6 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
7 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

8 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
9 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
10 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

11 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify by mail all persons issued
12 special license plates. The notice shall contain all necessary
13 information and shall contain instructions for the renewal procedure
14 upon presentation to a motor license agent or the Tax Commission.
15 The license plates shall be issued on a staggered system.

16 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
17 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
18 applications for special license plates authorized under this
19 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
20 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
21 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
22 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
23 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
24 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for

1 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
2 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
3 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

4 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
5 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
6 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
7 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
8 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
9 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
10 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
11 removed from the vehicle.

12 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
13 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
14 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
15 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
16 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
17 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
18 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
19 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
20 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

21 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
22 follows:

23 1. University or College Supporter License Plate - such plates
24 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

1 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
2 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
3 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

4 2. Environmental Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
7 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
8 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
9 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
10 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
12 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
13 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
14 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
15 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
16 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
17 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
18 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
19 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

20 3. Firefighter License Plate - such plates shall be designed
21 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
22 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
23 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
24 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an

1 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
2 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
3 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
4 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
5 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
6 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
7 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
8 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
9 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
10 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
11 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
14 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
15 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

16 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
18 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
19 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
20 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
21 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
22 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
23 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
24 plates.

1 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
3 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
6 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
7 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
8 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
9 the prevention of child abuse.

10 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

12 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plate -
13 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
14 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
15 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
16 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
17 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
18 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
19 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
20 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
21 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
23 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
24 issued;

1 7. Oklahoma History License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
3 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
4 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
5 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

6 8. Historic Route 66 License Plate - such:

7 a. vehicle plates shall be designed to honor historic
8 Route 66, also known as the "Mother Road". As
9 provided in this section, an amount of the fee
10 collected for each vehicle license plate shall be
11 apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society
12 Revolving Fund to be distributed to the Route 66
13 Museum located in Clinton, Oklahoma, and

14 b. motorcycle plates shall be designed in consultation
15 with the Oklahoma Route 66 Association, Inc. The
16 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
17 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Route 66
18 Association, Inc., for any licensing fees which may be
19 required in order to use the Oklahoma Route 66
20 Association, Inc., logo or design. The licensing
21 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma
22 Route 66 Association, Inc., of not more than Twenty
23 Dollars (\$20.00) for each motorcycle license plate
24 issued;

1 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
3 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
4 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
5 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
6 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
7 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
10 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
11 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
12 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
13 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
14 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
15 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
16 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
17 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
18 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

19 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
21 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
22 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
23 Revolving Fund;

1 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
4 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
5 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
6 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
7 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
8 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
9 provide services to crime victims;

10 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plate - such plates
11 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
12 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
13 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
14 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
15 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
16 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
17 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

18 14. Four-H Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
19 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
20 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
22 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
23 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
24

1 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
2 Section 1104.4 of this title;

3 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
5 by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
7 person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag in the
8 Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an amount
9 of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section
10 1104.3 of this title;

11 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
13 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
14 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
15 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
16 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
18 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
19 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

20 17. Support Education License Plate - such plates shall be
21 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
22 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
23 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
24 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license

1 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
2 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
3 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
4 follows:

- 5 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
6 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 7 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
8 Education Revolving Fund,
- 9 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
10 Career Technology Fund, and
- 11 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
12 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
13 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
14 Oklahoma Statutes.

15 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
16 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
17 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
18 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
19 paragraph;

20 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plate -
21 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
22 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
23 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
24 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as

1 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
2 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
3 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
4 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.

5 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
6 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
7 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
8 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
9 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
10 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
11 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
12 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
13 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

14 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plate - such plates
15 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
16 support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall be issued
17 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
18 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
19 shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo. The Tax
20 Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
21 licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any licensing
22 fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts of America
23 logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment
24

1 to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty Dollars
2 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
6 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
7 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
8 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
10 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
11 of this title;

12 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
16 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
18 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
19 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

20 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plate - such plates shall
21 be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of pregnant
22 women who are committed to placing their children for adoption and
23 wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive parents and
24 other created families to assist in the adoption and placement of

1 children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates shall be
2 designed and final terminology delivered in consultation with the
3 Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human Services.
4 Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited
5 in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury for and to be
6 used by the Department of Human Services for the implementation of
7 the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act specifically for
8 created families;

9 23. Choose Life License Plate - such plates shall be designed,
10 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
11 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
12 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
13 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
14 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
15 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
16 this title;

17 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
20 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
21 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
22 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
23 Section 1104.7 of this title;

24

1 25. Lions Club License Plate - such plates shall be designed
2 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
3 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
4 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
5 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
6 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
7 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
8 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
9 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
10 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
11 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
12 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

13 26. Color Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
15 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
16 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting

2 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
3 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
4 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
5 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
6 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
7 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
8 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
9 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
10 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plate - such plates
13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
14 support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The plate shall be
15 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon.
16 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing

16 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plate -
17 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to

19 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
20 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
21 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
22 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
23 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
24 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the

1 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
2 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of

9 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be

13 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate

15 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
16 one to a maximum of six. The plate shall contain the official
17 Support Our Troops Incorporated logo which includes the mark
18 "Support Our Troops" across the bottom of the plate. The Tax
19 Commission, if necessary, may enter into a licensing agreement with
20 Support Our Troops Incorporated for any licensing fees which may be
21 required in order to use the Support Our Troops Incorporated logo or
22 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 Support Our Troops Incorporated of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for
24 each license plate issued;

1 40. Folds of Honor Supporter License Plate - such plates shall
2 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
3 for Folds of Honor Incorporated, a nonprofit charitable organization
4 exempt from taxation pursuant to the provisions of the Internal
5 Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C., Section 501(c)(3), providing academic and
6 vocational training scholarships to dependents of military
7 servicemen and servicewomen who were either killed or wounded in
8 action due to military service in the war in Iraq or Afghanistan.
9 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support for the Piedmont Public Schools Education Foundation. Such

1 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Foundation. As
2 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
3 deposited in the Piedmont Education Foundation License Plate
4 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.28 of this title;

5 71. The Pride of Oklahoma License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
7 the University of Oklahoma Marching Band and shall be designed in
8 consultation with the University of Oklahoma Marching Band. The
9 Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
10 licensing agreement with the University of Oklahoma or the
11 University of Oklahoma Marching Band for any licensing fees which
12 may be required in order to use the applicable logo or design. The
13 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Pride of
14 Oklahoma Fund at the University of Oklahoma Foundation, Inc. of not
15 more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

16 72. Jenks Trojans License Plate - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 Jenks School District. The license plates shall be designed in
19 consultation with the administration of the Jenks School District.
20 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
21 agreement with the Jenks School District for any licensing fees
22 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
23 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
24

1 Jenks School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
2 each license plate issued;

3 73. Bixby Spartans License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Bixby School District. The license plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the administration of the Bixby School District.
7 The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a licensing
8 agreement with the Bixby School District for any licensing fees
9 which may be required in order to use the school district's logo or
10 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the
11 Bixby School District of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for
12 each license plate issued;

13 74. Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission License Plate - such plates
14 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 support for the Oklahoma aviation industry and to promote awareness
16 of aviation and aerospace. Such plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission and shall be
18 issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from
19 one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Twenty-four
20 Dollars (\$24.00) of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
21 Oklahoma Aeronautics Commission Revolving Fund, for expenditure as
22 provided in Section 91 of Title 3 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

23 75. Ducks Unlimited License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for

1 Ducks Unlimited. Such plates shall be designed in consultation with
2 Ducks Unlimited. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall be authorized to
3 enter into a licensing agreement with Ducks Unlimited for any
4 licensing fee which may be required in order to use the Ducks
5 Unlimited logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide for
6 a payment to Ducks Unlimited of not more than Twenty Dollars
7 (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

8 76. Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate - such
9 plates shall be issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
10 of those who are currently prisoners of war or missing in action and
11 provide financial support for current veterans. The license plates
12 shall be designed in consultation with Rolling Thunder Oklahoma. As
13 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
14 deposited in the Prisoner of War and Missing in Action License Plate
15 Revolving Fund created in Section ~~5 of this act~~ 1104.29 of this
16 title;

17 77. Woodward Boomers License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 the Woodward School District. The license plates shall be designed
20 in consultation with the administration of the Woodward School
21 District. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter into a
22 licensing agreement with the Woodward School District for any
23 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the school
24 district's logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to the Woodward School District of not more than
2 Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued; and

3 78. Clinton Public School Foundation License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the Clinton Public School Foundation. The
6 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Clinton
7 Public School Foundation. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to
8 enter into a licensing agreement with the Clinton Public School
9 Foundation for any licensing fees which may be required in order to
10 use the school foundation's logo or design. The licensing agreement
11 shall provide for a payment to the Clinton Public School Foundation
12 of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate
13 issued.

14 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
15 (\$35.00) per year of renewal and shall be in addition to all other
16 registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
17 Registration Act. The fee shall be apportioned as follows:

18 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per year of renewal or any other
19 amount as provided in this title of the fee shall be apportioned as
20 provided or deposited in a fund as specified within the paragraph
21 authorizing the special license plate;

22 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall
23 be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
24

1 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
2 Registration Act; and

3 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
4 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

5 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.7, is
6 amended to read as follows:

7 Section 1135.7 A. ~~Beginning January 1, 2006, the~~ The Oklahoma
8 Tax Commission or private vendor with whom the Commission has
9 contracted is authorized to design and issue special license plates
10 to any person that applies to the Tax Commission or private vendor
11 for the creation of a special license plate and meets the minimum
12 standards and qualifications specified in this section.

13 B. If the following standards and guidelines are satisfied, the
14 Tax Commission shall ~~issue~~ authorize the issuance a special license
15 plate to the person making application for the special license
16 plate:

17 1. The license plate is to:

18 a. show membership in or affiliation with an
19 organization, or

20 b. demonstrate support for an organization, group or
21 cause;

22 2. The license plate does not advertise or endorse a product,
23 brand, or service that is provided for sale;

1 3. The license plate does not promote any philosophy based on
2 prejudice or that is contrary to state civil rights laws; and

3 4. ~~Five hundred~~ Two hundred prepaid applications for the
4 special license plate are received by the Tax Commission or private
5 vendor.

6 C. The fee for special license plates ~~that do~~ shall be
7 determined in accordance with Section 1 of this act. If the special
8 license plate does not provide financial assistance the fee shall be
9 no less than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) per year of renewal and shall
10 be in addition to all other registration fees provided by the
11 Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
12 provided in this section, Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) of the fee shall
13 be apportioned as follows: Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special
14 license plate fee shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission
15 Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration of the Oklahoma
16 Vehicle License and Registration Act and the remaining ~~Seven Dollars~~
17 ~~(\$7.00)~~ amounts of the special license plate fee shall be
18 apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma~~
19 ~~Statutes~~ this title.

20 D. The fee for special license plates that provide financial
21 assistance shall be determined in accordance with Section 1 of this
22 act. Provided, the fee shall be no less than Thirty-five Dollars
23 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
24 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. ~~The~~

1 Thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) per year of renewal of the fee shall be
2 apportioned as follows:

3 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to
4 the License Plate Special Program Assistance Revolving Fund created
5 in Section ~~7 of this act~~ 1135.8 of this title to be used in the
6 manner detailed in the application for the special license plate;

7 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
8 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
9 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
10 and

11 3. ~~Seven Dollars (\$7.00)~~ Any remaining amounts of the fee shall
12 be apportioned as provided in Section 1104 of ~~Title 47 of the~~
13 ~~Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

14 E. If a person applies for a special license plate that
15 provides financial assistance, the application shall designate a
16 state agency to be responsible for expending the funds generated by
17 the special license plate and the application shall designate a
18 specific public purpose for which the funds are to be used. The
19 application shall include an acknowledgment from the designated
20 state agency of their agreement with acceptance of the designated
21 funds.

22 F. Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
23 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
24 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used

1 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
2 registered for the current year.

3 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
4 Commission or a motor license agent, unless authorized by the Tax
5 Commission to be renewed for a period greater than one (1) year.

6 The Tax Commission shall ~~annually~~ notify ~~by mail~~ all persons issued
7 special license plates of the renewal procedures prior to the
8 expiration of the special license plate. The notice shall contain
9 all necessary information and shall contain instructions for the
10 renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor license agent or the
11 Tax Commission. The license plates shall be issued on a staggered
12 system.

13 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
14 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
15 applications for special license plates authorized under this
16 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
17 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
18 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
19 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
20 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
21 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of Title 47 of the
22 Oklahoma Statutes for registration of a motor vehicle. The motor
23 license agent fees for acceptance of applications and renewals shall
24 be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

1 G. All special plates issued by the Tax Commission prior to the
2 effective date of this act shall not be subject to the requirements
3 and qualifications outlined in this section.

4 H. As used in this section, "person" includes an individual,
5 group, organization or not-for-profit corporation that is recognized
6 as such by the Internal Revenue Service.

7 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
