AMENDATORY 66 O.S. 2011, Section 128, is 19 amended to read as follows: 20 Section 128. A. It shall be the duty of every railroad company 21 or corporation doing business, or operating a line of railroad, 22 within this state, to construct a crossing across that portion of 23 its track, roadbed or right-of-way over which any public highway may 24 run, and maintain the same unobstructed, in a good condition for the

use of the public, and to build and maintain in good condition all bridges and culverts that may be necessary on its right-of-way at such crossing and in case any.

- B. Any railroad company or corporation that fails so to construct and maintain said crossing in accordance with the recommendations set forth in the United States Department of Transportation Railroad-Highway Grade Crossing Handbook, for thirty (30) days after written notice by the road overseer of any road district or the council or board of trustees of any city or town in this state, or fifty (50) petitioners of any city or town who are interested (where such work or repairs are needed), to be given Oklahoma Corporation Commission to the section boss, or any station agent or employee of any railroad company or corporation in the county (where such work or repairs are needed) it, shall forfeit and pay to said county, road district, city or town complaining, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) per day for every day said company or corporation may neglect to comply with the requirements of this section be subject to a contempt proceeding before the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.
  - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
