L 6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
L7	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L 8	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2254.2 of Title 74, unless there
L 9	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
21	fund for the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, to be
22	designated the "Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department
23	Reimbursement and Donation Fund". The fund shall be a continuing
24	fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of

1	donations, insurance reimbursements, Federal Emergency Management
2	Agency (FEMA) payments, and other reimbursement monies received by
3	the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department.
4	B. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby
5	appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
6	Tourism and Recreation Department.
7	C. No monies from this revolving fund shall be transferred for
8	any purpose to any other state agency. Expenditures from the fund
9	shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
10	claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office o
11	Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
