L7	A managed care entity, as defined in Section 6592 of Title 36 of
L 7	the Oklahoma Statutes, may not:
19	1. Require a physician participating in a managed care plan to
20	issue an immunization or vaccination protocol for an immunization or
21	vaccination to be administered to an enrollee in the plan;
22	2. Limit an enrollee's benefits for immunizations or
23	vaccinations to circumstances in which an immunization or
24	vaccination protocol is issued;

1	3. Provide a financial incentive to a physician to issue an
2	immunization or vaccination protocol; or
3	4. Impose a financial or other penalty on a physician who
4	refused to issue an immunization or vaccination protocol.
