7                               AS INTRODUCED

8           An Act relating to the Oklahoma Education Lottery  
9   Act; authorizing use of web application to submit  
10 lottery-sponsored and second-chance promotions;  
11 listing methods to legally obtain entries; construing  
provision; declaring law void based on certain court  
ruling; providing for codification and providing an  
effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15       SECTION 1.       NEW LAW       A new section of law to be codified  
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 724.5 of Title 3A, unless there  
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18       A.   Entries submitted by lottery players to the Oklahoma Lottery  
19 Commission for lottery-sponsored promotions and second-chance  
20 drawing promotions offered by the Commission may be submitted using  
21 a web application provided or sponsored by the Commission. All  
22 entries for lottery-sponsored promotions and second-chance drawing  
23 promotions shall be legally obtained from the Commission in one of  
24 the following ways:

1        1. Purchase of lottery tickets from the Commission or a lottery  
2 retailer;

3        2. Receipt of an entry-eligible lottery ticket from the  
4 Commission or from a lottery retailer; or

5        3. Receipt of a promotional entry from the Commission or a  
6 lottery retailer.

7        B. The process to submit entries to lottery-sponsored  
8 promotions and second-chance drawing promotions provided by  
9 subsection A of this section shall not be construed as illegal  
10 Internet gambling activities. If passage of this section of law is  
11 deemed by a court of law to allow any other form of Internet  
12 gambling activities in the state, then this section of law shall be  
13 rendered null and void.

14        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
