AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 5-135.4, as 19 amended by Section 1, Chapter 133, O.S.L. 2017 (70 O.S. Supp. 2017, 20 Section 5-135.4), is amended to read as follows: 2.1 Section 5-135.4 A. This section shall be known and may be 22 cited as the "School District Transparency Act". 23 By January 30, 2011 July 1, 2018, the State Department of 24

Education shall make school district and school site expenditure and

1 revenue data available on its website. Data shall be made available 2 in an open-structured data format that may be downloaded by the 3 public and that allows the user to systematically sort, search, and 4 access all data without any fee or charge for access. If a school 5 district has a website, the district shall include a link from the district homepage to the Department's Oklahoma Cost Accounting 6 7 System (OCAS) website for school district financial information where the district's financial information is available or shall 8 9 provide the information listed in subsection C of this section 10 within one click of the district's website homepage.

- C. The database website shall provide information on school district and school site expenditures and revenue of state, federal, and local funds, whether appropriated or nonappropriated, excluding payments of voluntary payroll deductions for employees to receiving parties. The database website shall further provide information, including, but not limited to, the following:
 - 1. Identification of the school district;
- 2. The Oklahoma Cost Accounting System (OCAS) code designation for each expenditure;
- 3. The name and principal location of the entity or recipient of the funds, excluding release of information relating to an individual's place of residence and release of information prohibited by subsection D of Section 24A.7 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes or by federal law relating to privacy rights;

- 1 4. The amount of funds expended;
 - 5. The type of transaction;

- 6. A descriptive purpose of the funding action or expenditure;
- 7. The budgeted and audited actual expenditure figures for each fiscal year, ensuring each set of figures can be identified as budgeted or audited figures; and
- 8. The per-pupil spending figure, derived by dividing total current expenditures by the total number of students enrolled for each school year.
- D. The Department shall make the data available on its website within one hundred twenty (120) days of transmission of the expenditures to the Department by the school district.
- E. School districts shall provide information requested by the Department to accomplish the purposes of this section.
- F. If a school district maintains a website, the district shall provide the information required in subsection C of this section in the manner prescribed in subsection B of this section on the district website.
- G. Nothing in this section shall require the disclosure of information which is required to be kept confidential by state or federal law.
- 22 H. The disclosure of information required by this section shall 23 create no liability whatsoever, civil or criminal, to the State of 24 Oklahoma, the State Department of Education, school districts, or

1	any employee thereof for disclosure of required information or for
2	any error or omission in the disclosure.
3	I. The Department shall annually inform parents, schools and
4	other stakeholders about the availability of school district and
5	school site expenditure and revenue data on its website and how to
6	use the website.
7	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
8	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
9	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
10	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
11	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
