7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to poor persons; amending 56 O.S.
9 2011, Section 1017.3, which relates to eligibility
10 for the Advantage Waiver Program; providing that
 certain determination be made by Oklahoma Health Care
 Authority; and providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 56 O.S. 2011, Section 1017.3, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 56-1017.3 To be eligible for the ADvantage Waiver
17 Program, a person shall:

- 18 1. Qualify financially for Medicaid;
- 19 2. Be sixty-five (65) years of age or older or be a physically
20 disabled adult as determined by the Social Security Administration,
21 age twenty-one (21) years or older without mental retardation or
22 cognitive impairment;

1 3. Be determined to meet the nursing facility institutional
2 level of care by the ~~Aging Services Division of the Department of~~
3 ~~Human Services~~ Oklahoma Health Care Authority;

4 4. Reside in his or her own home or a family member's home; and

5 5. Have needs that can be safely met with waiver services and
6 family or community supports.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
