13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2606 of Title 70, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 A. If a student withdraws from a class in which he or she has
18 received an award from the Oklahoma Higher Learning Access Program,
19 the awarded funds shall remain available for the student to use to
20 enroll in classes for a five-year period. If the student does not
21 use the awarded funds during the five-year period, the funds shall
22 be available for use for other students in the Oklahoma Higher
23 Learning Access Program.

1 B. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education shall
2 promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
