8                               COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

9           An Act relating to public finance; amending Section  
10       2, Chapter 325, O.S.L. 2017 (62 O.S. Supp. 2017,  
11       Section 8002), which relates to the Agency  
12       Performance and Accountability Commission;  
13       authorizing Commission to contract with Attorney  
14       General for legal advice; and declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16       SECTION 1.       AMENDATORY       Section 2, Chapter 325, O.S.L.  
17       2017 (62 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 8002), is amended to read as  
18       follows:

19       Section 8002.   A.   There is hereby created the Agency  
20       Performance and Accountability Commission which shall consist of:

21       1.   Three members appointed by the Governor:

22           a.   at least one of whom shall be the president, owner,  
23               chief executive officer or chief financial officer of  
24               an Oklahoma-based company, and

1           b.     at least one of whom shall be an auditor who is  
2                 employed as an internal auditor by a company or who is  
3                 employed by a private auditing firm;

4           2.   Three members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the  
5   Oklahoma Senate, at least one of whom shall be a business efficiency  
6   expert;

7           3.   Three members appointed by the Speaker of the Oklahoma House  
8   of Representatives, at least one of whom shall be a business  
9   efficiency expert; and

10          4.   The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise  
11   Services, or his or her designee who is an employee of the Office of  
12   Management and Enterprise Services, who shall be an ex officio and  
13   nonvoting member.

14          B.   No person shall be appointed to the Commission who at the  
15   time of his or her appointment is an elected official. Any person  
16   who is appointed to the Commission who subsequently becomes an  
17   elected official during his or her term on the Commission shall be  
18   required to vacate his or her position on the Commission.

19          C.   The Senate and the House of Representatives shall provide  
20   staff and administrative support to the Commission. The Commission  
21   shall contract with the Attorney General who shall provide legal  
22   advice on any matter related to the powers and duties of the  
23   Commission.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
