10	AS INTRODUCED
11	A Concurrent Resolution commemorating the sixtieth
12	anniversary of the North American Aerospace Defense Command and the partnership between the State of
13	Oklahoma and Canada and between the United States and Canada; and directing distribution.
14	
15	
16	WHEREAS, The United States and Canada share not only a secure
17	5,522-mile border, the world's longest, but also a vibrant history
18	of democratic governance, military and economic partnerships, and
19	cultural ties; and
20	WHEREAS, The United States' defense partnership with Canada is a
21	natural complement to the extensive geographic, political, economic,
22	cultural, and social ties that link our two countries and critical
23	for the security and wellbeing of both; and

1	WHEREAS, defense and security relations between our two
2	countries are long-standing, well-entrenched, and highly successful
3	underpinned by our integrated American and Canadian forces at North
4	American Aerospace Defense Command, or NORAD, which defends the
5	North American continent; and
6	WHEREAS, NORAD is a unique and indispensable expression of one
7	of the most extensive defense relationships in the world; and
8	WHEREAS, for sixty years, members of the Canadian armed forces
9	have served in Colorado Springs as partners in NORAD; and
10	WHEREAS, since 1979, Canadian Armed Forces personnel have been
11	stationed at Oklahoma's own Tinker Air Force Base in Oklahoma City
12	in support of NORAD; and
13	WHEREAS, the continued service with valor and honor of American
14	and Canadian men and women serving at the North American Aerospace
15	Defense Command is central to North America's ability to confront
16	and successfully defeat threats of the 21st century; and
17	WHEREAS, the continuation of the longstanding and successful
18	relationship between the United States and Canada through the North
19	American Aerospace Defense Command is paramount to the future
20	security of the people of the United States and Canada; and
21	WHEREAS, The United States and Canada have the largest and most
22	comprehensive trade relationship in the world, totaling nearly \$635
23	billion in goods and services crossing our shared border each year,
24	

1 with the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA) providing the framework for much of this bilateral trade; and 3 WHEREAS, Oklahoma contributes significantly to this 4 relationship, with bilateral trade totaling \$1.4 billion; and 5 WHEREAS, Canada is the largest foreign trade partner for the 6 United States and the top export destination for 32 states, 7 including Oklahoma; and WHEREAS, nearly 9 million American jobs are dependent on trade 8 9 with Canada, including over 50,700 jobs in Oklahoma. 10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 11 OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE, THE SENATE 12 CONCURRING THEREIN: 1.3 THAT the Legislature commemorates NORAD's 60th anniversary and 14 recognizes the contributions made by our American and Canadian 15 service men and women to jointly secure North America and promote 16 international peace and security. 17 THAT the Legislature recognizes the importance of Canada-18 Oklahoma trade economic and trade relationship. 19 THAT copies of this resolution be sent to President Donald J. 20 Trump; the Right Honorable Justin P.J Trudeau, Prime Minister of 21 Canada; Governor John W. Hickenlooper; James N. Mattis, Secretary of 22 Defense; the Honorable Rex Tillerson, Secretary of State; the 23 Honorable Chrystia Freeland, Minister of Foreign Affairs; the
