## 1 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - FLOOR VERSION 2 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 3 1st Session of the 56th Legislature (2017) 4 HOUSE RESOLUTION 1011 By: Vaughan 5 6 7 8 AS INTRODUCED 9 A Resolution recognizing April 6, 2017, as Tartan Day in Oklahoma; and directing distribution. 10 11 12 WHEREAS, on April 6, the United States observes National Tartan 13 Day, symbolizing the signing of the Declaration of Arbroath in 1320, 14 asserting Scotland's sovereignty over English territorial claims, 15 which later influenced the American Declaration of Independence; and 16 WHEREAS, National Tartan Day honors the role Scottish Americans 17 have played throughout this nation's history. For example, almost 18 half of the signers of the American Declaration of Independence in 19 1776 were of Scottish descent; and 20 WHEREAS, the United Scottish Clans of Oklahoma (USCO) and 21 Scottish Club of Tulsa (SCOT) represent the Scottish descendants and 22 enthusiasts in the State of Oklahoma, helping to promote Scottish 23 culture and heritage through Highland Games, music, dance and other 24

events; and

1	WHEREAS, Oklahoma hosts two Scottish festivals each year: the
2	Iron Thistle Scottish Heritage Festival and Highland Games,
3	sponsored by USCO and held in Yukon on April 28, 29 and 30, 2017;
4	and SCOTFEST, held in Tulsa on September 15, 16 and 17, 2017; and
5	WHEREAS, using the colors of red, white, black and gold on a
6	blue field, Oklahoma native, Jerrel R. Murray created a tartan that
7	is symbolic of the people, land and resources of Oklahoma; and
8	WHEREAS, this very special tartan was approved and registered
9	with the Tartan Registry Society and in 1999, the Oklahoma State
10	Legislature declared it to be the Official Tartan of Oklahoma.
11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
12	OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
13	THAT the Oklahoma State Legislature hereby recognizes April 6,
14	2017, as Tartan Day in the State of Oklahoma in recognition of the
15	important contributions of Scottish Americans to the development of
16	our state and nation.
17	THAT copies of this resolution be dispatched to the United
18	Scottish Clans of Oklahoma, the Scottish Club of Tulsa, the Iron
19	Thistle Heritage Festival and Highland Games, and SCOTFEST.
