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9 An Act relating to law enforcement training;
10 authorizing the Council on Law Enforcement Education
11 and Training to conduct training for certain
12 noncommissioned attendees; authorizing training
13 tuition and fees to be set by the Council; directing
14 deposit of tuition and fees; requiring certain
15 minimum requirements be met; authorizing emergency
16 rule making; providing for codification; and
17 providing an effective date.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

19 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3311.16 of Title 70, unless
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 A. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
23 (CLEET) is authorized to conduct full-time Basic Peace Officer
24 Certification Academies and other law enforcement related training

1 for individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law enforcement
2 agency under rules established by the Council.

3 B. The tuition and/or fees for attending the Basic Peace
4 Officer Certification Academies and/or other law enforcement related
5 training will be at a rate established by CLEET and approved by the
6 Council. Tuition and/or fees charged under this section will be
7 deposited in the Peace Officer Revolving Fund established in Section
8 3311.7 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

9 C. Individuals not commissioned or appointed by a law
10 enforcement agency who are trained in the Basic Peace Officer
11 Certification Academies will be required to meet minimum
12 requirements established for peace officers as set forth in Section
13 3311 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Any fees relating to
14 meeting these requirements shall be the responsibility of the
15 individual. Individuals applying for the Academies will be required
16 to submit a fingerprint check to CLEET prior to acceptance.

17 D. The Council is authorized to promulgate emergency rules to
18 effectuate the provisions of this subsection.

19 E. Upon successful completion of the Basic Peace Officer
20 Certification Academy, the individual's CLEET certification will
21 become effective upon employment by an Oklahoma law enforcement
22 agency. Employment and certification must be obtained within two
23 (2) years of completion of the Basic Peace Officer Certification
24 Academy.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
