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9           An Act relating to health insurance; amending 36 O.S.  
10   2011, Section 6060, which relates to mammography  
11   screenings; defining terms; specifying insurance  
12   coverage of certain mammograms; and providing an  
13   effective date.

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15   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16           SECTION 1.       AMENDATORY       36 O.S. 2011, Section 6060, is  
17   amended to read as follows:

18           Section 6060.   A.   For the purposes of this section,

19           1.   "Health benefit plan" means any plan or arrangement as  
20   defined in subsection C of Section 6060.4 of this title;

21           2.   "Low-dose mammography" means:

22                   a.   the x-ray examination of the breast using equipment  
23                   specifically dedicated for such purpose, with an  
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- 1                   average radiation exposure delivery of less than one  
2                   rad mid-breast and with two views for each breast,  
3            b.    digital mammography, or  
4            c.    breast tomosynthesis;

5        3.   "Breast tomosynthesis" means a radiologic mammography  
6 procedure involving the acquisition of projection images over a  
7 stationary breast to produce cross-sectional digital three-  
8 dimensional images of the breast from which breast cancer screening  
9 diagnoses may be made.

10       B.   All health benefit plans shall include the coverage  
11 specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening for  
12 the presence of occult breast cancer. Such coverage shall not:

13       1.   Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and co-  
14 insurance limits of the plan; or

15       2.   Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a  
16 specified time as a condition of payment.

17       ~~B.~~ C. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39)  
18 years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this  
19 section to coverage for a low-dose mammography screening once every  
20 five (5) years.

21       2.   Any female forty (40) years of age or older shall be  
22 entitled pursuant to the provisions of this section to coverage for  
23 an annual low-dose mammography screening.

4       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
