All health benefit plans shall include the coverage 11 specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening for 12 the presence of occult breast cancer. Such coverage shall not: 13 1. Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and coinsurance limits of the plan; or 14 2. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a 15 specified time as a condition of payment. 16 B. C. 1. Any female thirty-five (35) through thirty-nine (39) 17 years of age shall be entitled pursuant to the provisions of this 18 section to coverage for a low-dose mammography screening once every 19 five (5) years. 20 2.
