10 An Act relating to railroads; amending 66 O.S. 2011,
11 Section 128, which relates to crossing construction
12 requirements; limiting the space where crossing
13 construction is required; updating statutory
14 language; and providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 66 O.S. 2011, Section 128, is
17 amended to read as follows:

18 Section 128. It shall be the duty of every railroad company or
19 corporation doing business, or operating a line of railroad, within
20 this state, to construct a crossing, limited to the space between
21 the tracks and two (2) feet on either side thereof, across that
22 portion of its track, roadbed or right-of-way over which any public
23 highway may run, and maintain ~~the same~~ that crossing unobstructed,
24 and in a good condition for the use of the public₇; and to build and

1 maintain in good condition all bridges and culverts that may be
2 necessary on its right-of-way at such crossing ~~and in case.~~ If any
3 railroad company or corporation fails so to construct and maintain
4 said crossing for thirty (30) days after written notice by the road
5 overseer of any road district or the council or board of trustees of
6 any city or town in this state, or fifty petitioners of any city or
7 town who are interested (where such work or repairs are needed), to
8 be given to the section boss, or any station agent of any railroad
9 company or corporation in the county (where such work or repairs are
10 needed) it shall forfeit and pay to ~~said~~ the county, road district,
11 city or town complaining, the sum of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00)
12 per day for every day ~~said~~ the company or corporation may neglect to
13 comply with the requirements of this section.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
