9 An Act relating to commercial driver license; stating
10 certain exemption for hazardous material endorsement
11 if certain requirements are met; providing for
12 codification; and declaring an emergency.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-124 of Title 47, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Any person driving under a commercial class A license shall not
18 be required to obtain a hazardous material endorsement pursuant to
19 49 C.F.R. Section 383 if the person is:

20 1. Acting within the scope of the license holder's employment
21 as an employee of a custom harvester operation; and

22 2. Operating a service vehicle that is:

- 1 a. transporting diesel in a quantity of three thousand
2 seven hundred and eight-five (3,785) liters, or one
3 thousand (1,000) gallons or less, and
4 b. clearly marked with a "flammable" or "combustible"
5 placard, as appropriate.

6 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
