A new section of law to be codified 16 NEW LAW in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 271 of Title 19, unless there is 17 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 18 The county clerk in a county shall have the authority to employ 19 a general counsel through an outside law firm, to advise or 20 represent the county clerk and his or her office in the performance 21 of the official duties of that office. The Board of County 22 23 Commissioners shall approve all contracts for outside counsel. A
