12 An Act relating to Oklahoma Law Enforcement
13 Telecommunication System; amending 47 O.S. 2011,
14 Section 2-125, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 283,
15 O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016, Section 2-125),
16 which relates to the deposit and expenditures from
17 the Department of Public Safety Restricted Revolving
18 Fund; authorizing the assessment and collection of
19 certain costs and fees; authorizing certain types of
20 expenditures from Fund; requiring certain minimum
21 annual fund utilization for certain purpose; and
22 providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 2-125, as
22 amended by Section 3, Chapter 283, O.S.L. 2012 (47 O.S. Supp. 2016,
23 Section 2-125), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 2-125. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall ~~deposit~~
2 assess and collect costs and fees from subscribers to the Oklahoma
3 Law Enforcement Telecommunications System, to be deposited in the
4 State Treasury to the credit of the Department of Public Safety
5 Restricted Revolving Fund ~~any monies that are derived from user fees~~
6 ~~and.~~ Such costs and fees expended from the Fund shall be for
7 personnel, recurring user fees, necessary hardware and accessories,
8 ~~installation costs paid by subscribers for terminals that are a part~~
9 ~~of the Oklahoma Law Enforcement Telecommunication Systems. In~~
10 ~~addition to other purposes authorized by law, expenditures from the~~
11 ~~Fund shall be used for purchases of terminal equipment, installation~~
12 ~~costs, personnel, and other operating expenses of the Oklahoma Law~~
13 ~~Enforcement Telecommunication Systems~~ of equipment, maintenance and
14 operational expenses for the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
15 Telecommunication System; provided that no less than Seventy-five
16 Thousand Dollars (\$75,000.00) of such costs and fees shall be
17 utilized by the Department of Public Safety annually to fulfill the
18 Department's obligations related to Section 509.2 of Title 57 of the
19 Oklahoma Statutes.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
