12 ~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 67.16 of Title 72, unless there
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall create and
17 administer a registry of one hundred percent (100%) service-disabled
18 Oklahoma veterans. The registry shall record the name, rank and
19 branch of service and dates of service for all one hundred percent
20 (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans. The Department shall
21 establish a website portal and telephone number for all one hundred
22 percent (100%) service-disabled Oklahoma veterans to join the
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1 registry. The Department shall be responsible for verification of
2 all information provided through the registry.

3 B. For the purposes of this section, all members of the
4 registry shall be a veteran as defined in 38 U.S.C. 101, and shall
5 have been assigned a disability percentage of one hundred percent
6 (100%) by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs.

7 C. The Oklahoma Veterans Commission is authorized to promulgate
8 rules to implement the provisions of this section.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
