10       An Act relating to Consumer Credit Code; amending 14A  
11       O.S. 2011, Section 5-106, which relates to discharge  
12       for garnishment; deleting language; prohibiting  
13       discharge from employment for garnishment; providing  
14       an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

15   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16       SECTION 1.       AMENDATORY       14A O.S. 2011, Section 5-106, is  
17       amended to read as follows:

18       Section 5-106. No employer shall discharge an employee for the  
19       reason that a creditor of the employee has subjected or attempted to  
20       subject unpaid earnings of the employee to garnishment or like  
21       proceedings directed to the employer for the purpose of paying a  
22       judgment arising from a debt, consumer credit sale, consumer lease,  
23       or consumer loan, ~~unless the employer shall be served with~~

~~garnishment or like process issued to collect one or more judgments  
against the employee on more than two occasions within one year.~~

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
