15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 14A O.S. 2011, Section 5-106, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 5-106. No employer shall discharge an employee for the
19	reason that a creditor of the employee has subjected or attempted to
20	subject unpaid earnings of the employee to garnishment or like
21	proceedings directed to the employer for the purpose of paying a
22	judgment arising from a <u>debt,</u> consumer credit sale, consumer lease,
23	or consumer loan , unless the employer shall be served with
24	

1	garnishment or like process issued to collect one or more judgments
2	against the employee on more than two occasions within one year.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2018.
4	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
