9 An Act relating to political subdivisions;
10 establishing certain limitation on the use of
11 government property for certain purposes; providing
12 certain exception; providing for codification; and
13 providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9030.9 of Title 74, unless there
17 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 Political subdivisions of the state shall not sublet or
19 otherwise allow occupancy of public property for use as office space
20 for day-to-day business operations to organizations that engage in
21 collective bargaining. Nothing shall prohibit such organizations
22 from using such facilities for meetings.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective in accordance with the provision of Section 58 of Article V of the Oklahoma Constitution.
