10	COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE
11	An Act relating to mental health providers; creating
12	the Protection Against Sexual Exploitation By a Mental Health Services Provider Act; providing short
13	title; defining term; specifying punishments and fines for certain acts; providing for codification;
14	and providing an effective date.

16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-101 of Title 43A, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Protection
21	Against Sexual Exploitation by a Mental Health Services Provider
22	Act".
23	B. As used in the Protection Against Sexual Exploitation By a
24	Mental Health Services Provider Act:

"Therapeutic deception" means any act, scheme, plan or pattern by a licensed mental health professional:

- a. intended to cause a person to believe that performing, or failing to perform, an act would result in serious physical, financial or emotional harm or distress to or physical restraint against any person, and
- b. that can reasonably be construed as being for the purpose of sexual gratification of the licensed mental health professional.
- C. A licensed mental health professional as defined by Section 1-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes who engages in therapeutic deception of a patient or former patient shall be subject to any applicable criminal sanctions as follows:
- 1. A single act of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with one current or former patient shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board;
- 2. Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental health professional with one current or former patient shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing board; and

1	3. Multiple acts of therapeutic deception by a licensed mental
2	health professional with two or more current or former patients
3	shall be a felony punishable by a fine not exceeding Twenty Thousand
4	Dollars (\$20,000.00) and the immediate revocation of the licensed
5	mental health professional's license by the appropriate licensing
6	board.
7	D. Each licensing board with jurisdiction over the professions
8	specified in Section 1-103 of Title 43A of the Oklahoma Statutes
9	shall promptly report complaints of sexual exploitation made by
10	patients to a local law enforcement agency for criminal
11	investigation.
12	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
