12 amending 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as last
13 amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47
14 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 1135.3), which relates to
15 specialty license plates; creating the Special Forces
16 Association license plate; creating the Sons of the
17 American Revolution license plate; creating the
18 Daughters of the American Revolution license plate;
19 providing for design of plates; amending 47 O.S.
20 2011, Section 1135.5, as last amended by Section 1,
21 Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section
22 1135.5), which relates to specialty license plates;
23 updating and clarifying references; creating Down
24 Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma license
 plate; creating the Elk City Education Foundation
 license plate; creating A Brotherhood Aiming Toward

 Eagle Scout license plate; creating Extraordinary
 Educators license plate; providing for design of
 plates; providing for distribution of funds to

3 and providing an effective date.
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5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.3, as
7 last amended by Section 2, Chapter 331, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
8 2017, Section 1135.3), is amended to read as follows:

9 Section 1135.3 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
10 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
11 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support, interest, or
12 membership to or for an organization, occupation, cause or other
13 subject as provided by this section.

14 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
15 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
16 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
17 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
18 registered for the current year.

19 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
20 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
21 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
22 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
23 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
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1 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
2 issued on a staggered system.

3 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
4 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
5 applications for special license plates authorized under this
6 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
7 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
8 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
9 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
10 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
11 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
12 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
13 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
14 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

15 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
16 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
17 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
18 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
19 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
20 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
21 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
22 removed from the vehicle.

23 Except as otherwise provided in this section, for special
24 license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004, no special

1 license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax Commission
2 until the Commission receives one hundred (100) prepaid applications
3 therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by the Tax
4 Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
5 date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall be null
6 and void. In the event one hundred (100) prepaid applications are
7 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
8 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

9 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
10 follows:

11 1. Round and Square Dance License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
13 round and square dancing;

14 2. National Association for the Advancement of Colored People
15 License Plate - such plates shall be designed, subject to the
16 criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the NAACP, and
17 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the NAACP;

18 3. National Rifle Association License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the National Rifle Association, and issued to any
21 person wishing to demonstrate support for the National Rifle
22 Association;

23 4. Masonic Fraternity License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of

1 a Masonic Fraternity of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a
2 Masonic Fraternity license plate for each vehicle with a rated
3 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Masonic
4 Fraternity membership or upon the presentment of an application for
5 a Masonic Fraternity license plate authorized and approved by the
6 Grand Lodge of Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with the Masonic Fraternities of Oklahoma and shall
8 contain the Masonic emblem;

9 5. Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children License
10 Plate - such plates shall be designed to demonstrate support for
11 Shriner's Hospitals for Burned and Crippled Children and shall be
12 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Shriner's
13 Temple in Oklahoma. The license plate shall be designed in
14 consultation with the Shriner's Temples in Oklahoma and shall
15 contain the Shriner's emblem;

16 6. Balloonists License Plate - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for hot air
18 ballooning in this state;

19 7. Order of the Eastern Star License Plate - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member
21 of an Order of the Eastern Star. Such persons may apply for an
22 Order of the Eastern Star license plate for each vehicle with a
23 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an
24 Order of the Eastern Star membership or upon the presentment of an

1 application for an Order of the Eastern Star license plate
2 authorized and approved by the organization. The license plate
3 shall be designed in consultation with the Order of the Eastern Star
4 and shall contain the Order of the Eastern Star emblem;

5 8. Knights of Columbus License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a member of
7 the Knights of Columbus. Such persons may apply for a Knights of
8 Columbus license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
9 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of a Knights of Columbus
10 membership or upon the presentment of an application for a Knights
11 of Columbus license plate authorized and approved by the
12 organization. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
13 with the Knights of Columbus and shall contain the Knights of
14 Columbus emblem;

15 9. Jaycees License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
16 issued to members of the Jaycees. Persons applying for such license
17 plate must show proof of membership in the Jaycees. The license
18 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Jaycees;

19 10. Kiwanis International License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed and issued to members of Kiwanis International. Persons
21 applying for such license plate must show proof of membership in
22 Kiwanis International. The license plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with Kiwanis International;

1 11. Certified Public Accountants License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state who is a
3 Certified Public Accountant. Such persons may apply for a Certified
4 Public Accountant license plate for each vehicle with a rated
5 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of status as a
6 Certified Public Accountant. The license plates shall be designed
7 in consultation with the Oklahoma Society of Certified Public
8 Accountants;

9 12. Civil Emergency Management License Plate - such plates
10 shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate
11 support for the state civil emergency management system. Persons
12 applying for such license plate must show proof of official
13 affiliation by presenting a nonexpired proof of employment,
14 affiliation or retirement in the form of an identification card or
15 letter on official letterhead from a municipal, county or state
16 emergency management department head;

17 13. Civilian Conservation Corps License Plate - such plates
18 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
19 Commission, by the Civilian Conservation Corps Association, and
20 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Civilian
21 Conservation Corps;

22 14. Rotarian License Plate - such plates shall be designed and
23 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of a Rotarian
24 Club of Oklahoma. Such persons may apply for a Rotarian license

1 plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton
2 or less upon proof of a Rotarian Club membership or upon the
3 presentment of an application for a Rotarian license plate
4 authorized and approved by a Rotarian Club of Oklahoma. The license
5 plates shall be designed in consultation with the five Rotarian
6 District Governors and shall contain the Rotarian emblem;

7 15. Benevolent Protective Order of Elks License Plate - such
8 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
9 Tax Commission, by the Benevolent Protective Order of Elks, and
10 issued to any resident of this state who is a member of the
11 Benevolent Protective Order of Elks;

12 16. Humane Society License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
14 the Humane Society of the United States. The plates shall be issued
15 to any person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to
16 a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate
17 shall contain the official Humane Society logo;

18 17. Oklahoma Mustang Club License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission,
20 by the Oklahoma Mustang Club, and issued to any resident of this
21 state who is a member of the Oklahoma Mustang Club. Such persons
22 may apply for an Oklahoma Mustang Club license plate upon
23 presentment of proof of membership in the Oklahoma Mustang Club.
24 The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of

1 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
2 personalized license plates;

3 18. American Business Clubs (AMBUCS) License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to members of American Business
5 Clubs. Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of
6 membership in AMBUCS. The license plates shall be designed in
7 consultation with American Business Clubs;

8 19. West Point 200th Anniversary License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
10 the Two Hundredth Anniversary of the founding of the United States
11 Military Academy at West Point, New York. The license plates shall
12 be designed in consultation with the West Point Society of Central
13 Oklahoma;

14 20. Oklahoma Aquarium License Plate - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the Oklahoma Aquarium. The license plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the Oklahoma Aquarium;

18 21. The Pride of Broken Arrow License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
20 for The Pride of Broken Arrow marching band. The plates shall be
21 designed in consultation with the Broken Arrow Public School System;

22 22. Fellowship of Christian Athletes License Plate - such
23 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Fellowship of
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1 Christian Athletes and issued to members and supporters of the
2 Fellowship of Christian Athletes;

3 23. Parrothead Club License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to members and supporters of the Parrothead
5 Club. The license plate shall be issued to any person in any
6 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven as
7 for personalized license plates;

8 24. Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of the
10 Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition. The license plates shall be designed
11 in consultation with the Oklahoma Bicycling Coalition;

12 25. Electric Lineman License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
14 Oklahoma's electric linemen. The license plates shall be designed
15 in consultation with the Oklahoma Electric Superintendent's
16 Association;

17 26. Alpha Kappa Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Kappa
19 Alpha Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
20 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha
21 Sorority;

22 27. The National Pan-Hellenic Council Incorporated License
23 Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to any person
24 wishing to demonstrate support to any of the nine sororities and

1 fraternities recognized by the National Pan-Hellenic Council
2 Incorporated. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
3 with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Pan-Hellenic Council
4 Incorporated;

5 28. Organ, Eye and Tissue License Plate - such plates shall be
6 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support and
7 increase awareness for organ, eye and tissue donation. The license
8 plates shall be designed in consultation with the State Department
9 of Health;

10 29. Central Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity License Plate - such
11 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
12 demonstrate support and increase awareness for Habitat for Humanity.
13 The license plate shall be designed in consultation with Central
14 Oklahoma Habitat for Humanity;

15 30. Family Career and Community Leaders of America Incorporated
16 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
17 wishing to demonstrate support for Family Career and Community
18 Leaders of America Incorporated. The license plates shall be
19 designed in consultation with Family Career and Community Leaders of
20 America Incorporated;

21 31. Delta Sigma Theta License Plate - such plates shall be
22 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Delta Sigma
23 Theta Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in
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1 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority
2 Incorporated;

3 32. Omega Psi Phi License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person who is a member of Omega Psi Phi
5 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
6 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Incorporated;

7 33. Alpha Phi Alpha License Plate - such plates shall be
8 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Alpha Phi Alpha
9 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
10 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity
11 Incorporated;

12 34. 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System of Highways
13 License Plate - such plates shall be designed and issued to persons
14 wishing to commemorate the 50th Anniversary of the Interstate System
15 of Highways. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
16 with the American Association of State Highway and Transportation
17 Officials;

18 35. Kappa Alpha Psi License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Kappa Alpha Psi
20 Fraternity. The license plates shall be designed in consultation
21 with the Oklahoma Chapter of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity
22 Incorporated;

23 36. Sigma Gamma Rho License Plate - such plates shall be
24 designed and issued to any person who is a member of Sigma Gamma Rho

1 Sorority. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
2 the Oklahoma Chapter of Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority Incorporated.

3 Subject to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Sigma
4 Gamma Rho License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1,
5 2013;

6 37. Multiple Sclerosis License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
8 and increase awareness of multiple sclerosis. The license plates
9 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the
10 National Multiple Sclerosis Society;

11 38. Frederick Douglass High School License Plate - such plates
12 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
13 support for Frederick Douglass High School located in Oklahoma City.
14 The plates shall be designed in consultation with representatives of
15 Frederick Douglass High School National Alumni Association;

16 39. United States Air Force Academy License Plate - such plates
17 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
18 support for the United States Air Force Academy;

19 40. In God We Trust License Plate - such plates shall be
20 designed to include the motto, "In God We Trust", and shall be
21 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the motto;

22 41. National Weather Center License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
24 for the National Weather Center in Norman. The plates shall be

1 designed in consultation with representatives of the National
2 Weather Center Directors;

3 42. Make-A-Wish Foundation License Plate - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Make-A-Wish Foundation. The license plates shall be designed in
6 consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter of the National Make-A-Wish
7 Foundation;

8 43. South Central Section PGA Foundation License Plate - such
9 plates shall be designed and issued to persons wishing to
10 demonstrate support for the South Central Section PGA Foundation.
11 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the South
12 Central Section PGA Foundation;

13 44. Putnam City High School License Plate - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
15 for Putnam City High School. The plates shall be designed in
16 consultation with representatives of Putnam City High School Alumni
17 Association, Inc.;

18 45. Autism Awareness License Plate - such plates shall be
19 designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness of
20 autism. The license plate shall be designed in consultation with
21 the Oklahoma Autism Network;

22 46. Oklahoma Blood Institute License Plate - such plates shall
23 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
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1 for the Oklahoma Blood Institute. The license plates shall be
2 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Blood Institute;

3 47. Zeta Phi Beta and Phi Beta Sigma License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person who is a member of
5 Zeta Phi Beta Sorority or Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity. The license
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma chapters
7 of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority Incorporated and Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity
8 Incorporated;

9 48. Star Spencer High School License Plate - such plates shall
10 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
11 for Star Spencer High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates
12 shall be designed in consultation with representatives of the Star
13 Spencer High School Alumni Association. Subject to the provisions
14 of subsection A of this section, the Star Spencer High School
15 License Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2015;

16 49. Northeast High School License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 Northeast High School located in Oklahoma City. The plates shall be
19 designed in consultation with representatives of the Northeast High
20 School Alumni Association;

21 50. Oklahoma City Central High School License Plate - such
22 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
23 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
24 Association. The plates shall be designed in consultation with

1 representatives of the Oklahoma City Central High School Alumni
2 Association;

3 51. Historic Greenwood District License Plate - such plates
4 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for music
5 festivals held in the Historic Greenwood District in Tulsa,
6 Oklahoma. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with
7 the Greenwood Cultural Center;

8 52. Oklahoma Rifle Association License Plate - such plates
9 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for the Oklahoma Rifle Association. The plates shall be
11 designed in consultation with representatives of the Oklahoma Rifle
12 Association;

13 53. Oklahoma City Thunder License Plate - such plates shall be
14 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
15 the Oklahoma City Thunder. The license plate shall be designed in
16 consultation with the Oklahoma City Thunder organization;

17 54. Ovarian Cancer Awareness License Plate - such plates shall
18 be designed and issued to any person wishing to increase awareness
19 of ovarian cancer. The license plate shall be designed in
20 consultation with the HOPE in Oklahoma organization;

21 55. BMW Car Club of America License Plate - such plates shall
22 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
23 for the BMW Car Club of America. The plates shall be issued to any
24 person in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a

1 maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates. The license
2 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Sunbelt Chapter of
3 the BMW Car Club of America. Subject to the provisions of
4 subsection A of this section, the BMW Car Club of America License
5 Plate is hereby reauthorized effective November 1, 2013;

6 56. Don't Tread On Me License Plate - such plates shall be
7 designed to include the yellow background and rattlesnake emblem
8 above the motto "DON'T TREAD ON ME" as found on the historic Gadsden
9 flag, and shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
10 support for the freedom and liberty of the Republic;

11 57. Oklahomans for the Arts License Plate - such plates shall
12 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
13 for arts, culture and creative industries as well as arts education.
14 The plates shall be designed in consultation with Oklahomans for the
15 Arts;

16 58. Oklahoma City Barons License Plate - such plates shall be
17 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
18 the Oklahoma City Barons. The license plate shall be designed in
19 consultation with the Oklahoma City Barons organization. The
20 license plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of
21 numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six;

22 59. Oklahoma City Redhawks License Plate - such plates shall be
23 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
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1 the Oklahoma City Redhawks. The license plate shall be designed in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma City Redhawks organization;

3 60. Tulsa Shock License Plate - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
5 Tulsa Shock. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
6 with the Tulsa Shock organization;

7 61. Tulsa Oilers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
8 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
9 Tulsa Oilers. The license plate shall be designed in consultation
10 with the Tulsa Oilers organization;

11 62. Tulsa Drillers License Plate - such plates shall be
12 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
13 the Tulsa Drillers. The license plate shall be designed in
14 consultation with the Tulsa Drillers organization;

15 63. Millwood School District License Plate - such plates shall
16 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
17 for the Millwood School District. The license plate shall be
18 designed in consultation with representatives of the Millwood School
19 District;

20 64. Booker T. Washington High School License Plate - such
21 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
22 Booker T. Washington High School and shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Booker T. Washington High School National
24 Alumni Association;

1 65. Oklahoma Current State Flag License Plate - such plates
2 shall be designed to include the current Oklahoma state flag and
3 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the current
4 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
5 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center;

6 66. Oklahoma Original State Flag License Plate - such plates
7 shall be designed to include the original Oklahoma state flag and
8 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the original
9 Oklahoma state flag. The plates shall be designed in consultation
10 with the Friends of the Oklahoma History Center. The plates shall
11 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
12 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized plates. Subject
13 to the provisions of subsection A of this section, the Oklahoma
14 Original State Flag license plate is hereby reauthorized effective
15 November 1, 2015;

16 67. Tulsa 66ers License Plate - such plates shall be designed
17 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 Tulsa 66ers. The plates shall be designed in consultation with the
19 Tulsa 66ers Organization;

20 68. Frederick Bombers License Plate - such plates shall be
21 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Frederick
22 School District and shall be designed in consultation with
23 representatives of the Frederick School District;
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1 69. 911 Dispatcher License Plate - such plates shall be issued
2 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for 911 dispatchers.
3 Persons applying for such license plate must show proof of current
4 employment as a 911 dispatcher or sign an attestation that they are
5 a currently employed or retired 911 dispatcher;

6 70. Oklahoma Fosters License Plate - such plates shall be
7 issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
8 Fosters Initiative and shall be designed in consultation with the
9 Oklahoma Fosters Initiative; ~~and~~

10 71. Red Dirt Jeeps - such plates shall be designed and issued
11 to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Red Dirt Jeeps and
12 such plates shall be designed in consultation with Red Dirt Jeeps,
13 L.L.C.;

14 72. Special Forces Association - such plates shall be designed
15 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the
16 Special Forces Association and such plates shall be designed in
17 consultation with the Special Forces Association;

18 73. Sons of the American Revolution License Plate - such plates
19 shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the
20 Sons of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle in any
21 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
22 as for personalized plates. Such plates shall be designed in
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Society of the Sons of the American
24 Revolution. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of similar

1 design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the space
2 requirements of a motorcycle license plate; and

3 74. Daughters of the American Revolution License Plate - such
4 plates shall be issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
5 the Daughters of the American Revolution for a vehicle or motorcycle
6 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
7 seven, as for personalized plates. Such plates shall be designed in
8 consultation with the Oklahoma Society of the Daughters of the
9 American Revolution. The license plate for a motorcycle may be of
10 similar design as space permits or a new design in order to meet the
11 space requirements of a motorcycle license plate.

12 C. The fee for such plates shall be Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00)
13 and shall be in addition to all other registration fees provided by
14 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. Unless otherwise
15 provided in this section, the fee shall be apportioned as follows:
16 Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the special license plate fee shall be
17 deposited in the Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be
18 used for the administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and
19 Registration Act and the remaining Seven Dollars (\$7.00) of the
20 special license plate fee shall be apportioned as provided in
21 Section 1104 of this title.

22 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 1135.5, as
23 last amended by Section 1, Chapter 339, O.S.L. 2017 (47 O.S. Supp.
24 2017, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

1 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
2 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
3 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
4 financial assistance as provided by this section.

5 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
6 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
7 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
8 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
9 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

10 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
11 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
12 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.
13 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
14 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
15 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
16 issued on a staggered system.

17 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
18 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
19 applications for special license plates authorized under this
20 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
21 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
22 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
23 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
24 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents

1 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
2 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
3 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
4 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

5 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
6 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
7 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
8 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
9 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
10 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration
11 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
12 removed from the vehicle.

13 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
14 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
15 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
16 applications therefor. The prepaid applications must be received by
17 the Tax Commission within one hundred eighty (180) days of the
18 effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue shall
19 be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid applications are
20 not received by the Tax Commission within such prescribed time
21 period any payment so received shall be refunded accordingly.

22 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
23 follows:
24

1 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
3 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
4 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
5 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

6 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
7 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
8 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
9 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
10 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
11 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
12 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
14 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
15 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
16 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
17 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
18 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
19 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
20 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
21 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

22 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
23 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
24 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four

1 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
2 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
3 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
4 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
5 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
6 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
7 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
8 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated
9 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
10 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
11 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
12 of the fire department. The license plate shall be designed in
13 consultation with the Oklahoma Firefighters Association.

14 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
15 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
16 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighters Museum and
17 the Oklahoma Fallen and Living Firefighters Memorial;

18 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
19 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
20 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
21 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
22 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
23 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
24 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may

1 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
2 plates.

3 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
4 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
5 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
7 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
8 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
9 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
10 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
11 the prevention of child abuse.

12 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
13 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

14 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
15 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
16 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
17 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
18 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
19 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
20 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
21 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
22 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
23 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
24 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not

1 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
2 issued;

3 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
4 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
5 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
7 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

8 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
10 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
11 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
12 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
13 Oklahoma;

14 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
16 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
17 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided
18 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
19 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
20 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

21 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
22 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
23 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
24 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying

1 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
2 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
3 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
4 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
5 collected shall be apportioned to the Emergency Medical Personnel
6 Death Benefit Revolving Fund created in Section 1-2505.2 of Title 63
7 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

8 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
9 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
10 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
11 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
12 Revolving Fund;

13 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
14 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
15 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
16 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims
17 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
19 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
20 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
21 provide services to crime victims;

22 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
24 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The

1 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
3 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
4 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
5 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

6 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
7 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
8 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
10 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
11 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
12 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
13 Section 1104.4 of this title;

14 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
15 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
16 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
17 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
18 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
19 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
20 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
21 Section 1104.3 of this title;

22 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
23 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
24 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The

1 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
2 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
3 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
5 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
6 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

7 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
8 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
9 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
10 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
11 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
12 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
13 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three
14 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
15 follows:

- 16 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
17 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 18 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
19 Education Revolving Fund,
- 20 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
21 Career Technology Fund, and
- 22 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
23 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
24

1 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes.

3 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
4 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
5 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
6 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
7 paragraph;

8 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
9 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
10 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
11 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
12 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
13 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate
14 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
15 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
16 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
17 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
18 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
19 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
20 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
21 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
22 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
23 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
24

1 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
2 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

3 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
5 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
6 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
7 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
8 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
9 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
10 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
11 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
12 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide
13 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
14 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

15 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
16 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
17 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
18 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
19 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
20 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
21 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
22 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
23 of this title;

1 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
2 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
3 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
4 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
5 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
6 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
7 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
8 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

9 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
10 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
11 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
12 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive
13 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
14 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
15 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
16 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
17 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
18 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
19 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
20 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
21 specifically for created families;

22 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
23 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
24 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of

1 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
2 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
3 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
4 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
5 this title;

6 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
7 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
8 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
9 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an
11 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
12 Section 1104.7 of this title;

13 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
14 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
15 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
16 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
17 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
18 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
19 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
20 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
22 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
23 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
24 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

1 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
2 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
3 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
4 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
5 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
6 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
7 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
8 Section 1104.8 of this title;

9 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
10 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
11 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
12 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
13 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
14 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
15 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
16 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
17 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
18 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
19 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
20 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
21 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
22 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
23 plate issued;

1 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
2 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
3 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
4 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
5 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
6 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
7 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
8 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing
9 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
10 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
11 plate issued;

12 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
13 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
14 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
15 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
16 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

17 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
18 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
19 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
20 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
21 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
22 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
23 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
24 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

1 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
2 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
3 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
4 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
6 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
7 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet
8 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
9 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
10 Section 1104.10 of this title;

11 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
12 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
13 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
14 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
15 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
16 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
17 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
18 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
19 Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.11 of this title;

20 33. Global War on Terrorism License Plate - such plate shall be
21 designed in consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma
22 and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma
23 residents who are members of the Armed Forces of the United States
24 or Oklahoma National Guard that have served in the Global War on

1 Terrorism. The plate shall be issued to any person in any
2 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of six. As
3 provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected shall be
4 deposited in the 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in
5 Section 235.1 of Title 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

6 34. Boys and Girls Clubs of America Supporter License Plates -
7 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
8 demonstrate support for the Boys and Girls Clubs of America. The
9 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
10 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized
11 license plates. The plate shall contain the official Boys and Girls
12 Clubs of America logo. The Tax Commission, if necessary, may enter
13 into a licensing agreement with the Boys and Girls Clubs of America
14 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
15 Boys and Girls Clubs of America logo or design. The licensing
16 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Boys and Girls Clubs of
17 America of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
18 plate issued;

19 35. Oklahoma Quarter Horse License Plates - such plates shall
20 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support
21 for the American Quarter Horse in Oklahoma. The plate shall be
22 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Quarter Horse
23 Association. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee
24

1 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Quarter Horse Revolving
2 Fund created in Section 1104.12 of this title;

3 36. Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License Plate - such
4 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
5 Association for the Deaf and issued to any person wishing to
6 demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who are deaf. The plates
7 shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and
8 letters from one to maximum of seven, as for personalized license
9 plates. As provided in this section, a portion of the fee collected
10 shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Association for the Deaf License
11 Plate Revolving Fund created in Section 1104.15 of this title;

2 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
3 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
4 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

5 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
6 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
7 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
8 license plate;

9 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
10 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
11 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
12 and

13 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
14 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

15 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.30 of Title 47, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
19 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Down Syndrome
20 Association of Central Oklahoma license plates shall be deposited to
21 the Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
22 Revolving Fund created in subsection B of this section.

23 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
24 fund for the State Department of Human Services to be designated the

1 "Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma License Plate
2 Revolving Fund". The fund shall consist of all monies received
3 pursuant to subsection A of this section. All monies accruing to
4 the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted
5 and expended by the State Department of Human Services for grants to
6 the Down Syndrome Association of Central Oklahoma to raise awareness
7 and provide resources, as well as promote acceptance and inclusion
8 for people with Down Syndrome. Expenditures from the fund shall be
9 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
10 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
11 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

12 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.31 of Title 47, unless
14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
16 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Elk City
17 Education Foundation plates shall be deposited to the Elk City
18 Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund created in
19 subsection B of this section.

20 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
21 fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the "Elk
22 City Education Foundation License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund
23 shall consist of all monies received pursuant to subsection A of
24 this section. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund are

1 hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State
2 Department of Education for grants to the Elk City Education
3 Foundation to fund scholarships and teacher grants to Elk City
4 School District's students and teachers. Expenditures from the fund
5 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
6 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
7 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

8 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.30 of Title 47, unless
10 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
12 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Extraordinary
13 Educators License Plate shall be deposited in the Extraordinary
14 Educators License Plate Revolving Fund created in subsection B of
15 this section.

16 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
17 fund for the State Department of Education to be designated the
18 "Extraordinary Educators License Plate Revolving Fund". The fund
19 shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations,
20 and shall consist of all monies received by the Department pursuant
21 to the provisions of subsection A of this section. All monies
22 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may
23 be budgeted and expended by the Department for the purpose of
24 providing grants to school superintendents for distribution to

1 educators who propose extraordinary activities, projects or lessons
2 for students from kindergarten through eighth grade. Expenditures
3 from the fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State
4 Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by law with the
5 Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services for
6 approval and payment.

7 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
