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10       An Act relating to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous  
11       Substances Act; amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-206,  
12       as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 390, O.S.L.  
13       2017 (63 O.S. Supp. 2017, Section 2-206), which  
14       relates to Schedule II; modifying inclusions; and  
15       providing an effective date.

16   BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17       SECTION 1.       AMENDATORY       63 O.S. 2011, Section 2-206, as  
18       last amended by Section 3, Chapter 390, O.S.L. 2017 (63 O.S. Supp.  
19       2017, Section 2-206), is amended to read as follows:

20       Section 2-206. The controlled substances listed in this section  
21       are included in Schedule II.

22       A. Any of the following substances except those narcotic drugs  
23       listed in other schedules whether produced directly or indirectly by  
24       extraction from substances of vegetable origin, or independently by

1 means of chemical synthesis, or by combination of extraction and  
2 chemical synthesis:

3 1. Opium and opiate, and any salt, compound, derivative, or  
4 preparation of opium or opiate;

5 2. Any salt, compound, isomer, derivative, or preparation  
6 thereof which is chemically equivalent or identical with any of the  
7 substances referred to in paragraph 1 of this subsection, but not  
8 including the isoquinoline alkaloids of opium;

9 3. Opium poppy and poppy straw; or

10 4. Coca leaves except coca leaves and extracts of coca leaves  
11 from which cocaine, ecgonine, and derivatives of ecgonine or their  
12 salts have been removed; cocaine, its salts, optical and geometric  
13 isomers, and salts of isomers; ecgonine, its derivatives, their  
14 salts, isomers and salts of isomers; or any compound, mixture or  
15 preparation which contains any quantity of any of the substances  
16 referred to in this paragraph. Ioflupane is excluded from this  
17 paragraph.

18 B. Any of the following opiates, including their isomers,  
19 esters, ethers, salts, and salts of isomers, esters and ethers, when  
20 the existence of these isomers, esters, ethers, and salts is  
21 possible within the specific chemical designation:

22 1. Alphaprodine;

23 2. Anileridine;

24 3. Bezitramide;

- 1 4. Dihydrocodeine;
- 2 5. Diphenoxylate;
- 3 6. Fentanyl;
- 4 7. Hydromorphone;
- 5 8. Isomethadone;
- 6 9. Levomethorphan;
- 7 10. Levorphanol;
- 8 11. Metazocine;
- 9 12. Methadone;
- 10 13. Methadone - Intermediate, 4-cyano-2-dimethylamino-4, 4-
- 11 diphenyl butane;
- 12 14. Moramide - Intermediate, 2-methyl-3-morpholino-1, 1-
- 13 diphenyl-propane-carboxylic acid;
- 14 15. Oxycodone;
- 15 16. Oxymorphone;
- 16 17. Pethidine (Meperidine);
- 17 18. Pethidine - Intermediate - A, 4-cyano-1-methyl-4-
- 18 phenylpiperidine;
- 19 19. Pethidine - Intermediate - B, ethyl-4-phenylpiperidine-4-
- 20 carboxylate;
- 21 20. Pethidine - Intermediate - C, 1-methyl-4-phenylpiperidine-
- 22 4-carboxylic acid;
- 23 21. Phenazocine;
- 24 22. Piminodine;

23. Racemethorphan;

24. Racemorphan;

25. Etorphine Hydrochloride salt only;

26. Alfentanil hydrochloride;

27. Levo-alphaacetylmethadol;

28. Codeine;

29. Hydrocodone;

30. Morphine;

31. Remifentanil;

32. Sufentanil; or

33. Tapentadol.

C. Any substance which contains any quantity of:

1. Methamphetamine, including its salts, isomers, and salts of isomers;

2. Amphetamine, its salts, optical isomers, and salts of its optical isomers;

3. Nabilone; or

4. Lisdexamfetamine.

D. Unless specifically excepted or unless listed in another schedule, any material, compound, mixture, or preparation, which contains any quantity of the following substances having stimulant or depressant effect on the central nervous system:

1. Phenmetrazine and its salts;

1        2. Methylphenidate, including its salts, isomers and salts of  
2 isomers;

3        3. Amobarbital;

4        4. Pentobarbital;

5        5. Secobarbital; or

6        6. Ethylphenidate.

7        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
