22 team brought home the gold ball on March 4, 2017, after defeating
23 the eighth-ranked LeFlore to win the Class B Boys Basketball State

1 WHEREAS, the Chieftains conquered Tyron, Kinta and LeFlore
2 during the state tournament to win its first championship since
3 back-to-back titles in 2003 and 2004; and

4 WHEREAS, the Chieftains ended the season with a remarkable 27-4
5 season record earning its fourth over-all state title; and

6 WHEREAS, Calumet High School junior, Riley Island, helped lead
7 the Chieftains to victory with seven 3-pointers, seven assists and
8 eight rebounds in the 63-54 win over LeFlore; and

9 WHEREAS, the Chieftains are graduating three senior starters –
10 Aaron Thornton, Case Epperson and Stavion Blackowl; and

11 WHEREAS, junior starters Kobe Kennedy and Riley Island will
12 return with some other young players coming up to fight to win
13 another title next season.
