10	Section 1.1, which relates to agricultural activities as nuisance; clarifying language; providing requirements to determine established date of operation for certain agricultural activities; and providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:									
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 50 O.S. 2011, Section 1.1, is									
16	amended to read as follows:									
17	Section 1.1 A. As used in this section:									
18	1. "Agricultural activities" includes, but is not limited to,									
19	the growing or raising of horticultural and viticultural crops,									
20	berries, poultry, livestock, aquaculture, grain, mint, hay, dairy									
21	products and forestry activities. "Agricultural activities" also									
22	includes improvements or expansion to the activities provided for in									
23	this paragraph including, but not limited to, new technology, pens,									
24	barns, fences, and other improvements designed for the sheltering,									

- restriction, or feeding of animal or aquatic life, for storage of produce or feed, or for storage or maintenance of implements. If the expansion is part of the same operating facility, the expansion need not be contiguous;
 - 2. "Farmland" includes, but is not limited to, land devoted primarily to production of livestock or agricultural commodities; and
 - 3. "Forestry activity" means any activity associated with the reforesting, growing, managing, protecting and harvesting of timber, wood and forest products including, but not limited to, forestry buildings and structures.
 - B. Agricultural activities conducted on farm or ranch land, if consistent with good agricultural practices and established prior to nearby nonagricultural activities, are presumed to be reasonable and do not constitute a nuisance unless the activity has a substantial adverse affect effect on the public health and safety.

If that agricultural activity is undertaken in conformity with federal, state and local laws and regulations, it is presumed to be good agricultural practice and not adversely affecting the public health and safety.

C. No action for nuisance shall be brought against agricultural activities on farm or ranch land which has lawfully been in operation for two (2) years or more prior to the date of bringing the action. The established date of operation is the date on which

- 19 aggregate amount of costs and expenses determined by the court to
- 20 have been reasonably incurred in connection with defending the
- 21 action, together with a reasonable amount for attorney fees fee.
- 22 E. This section does not relieve agricultural activities of the
- 23 duty to abide by state and federal laws, including, but not limited

to, the Oklahoma Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations Act and the
