## COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE

```
[ public health - State Board of Health to promulgate
rules requiring certain dementia training -
codification - effective date ]
```

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1991 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Health shall promulgate rules that require all medical and direct care staff of nursing and specialized facilities, adult day care centers, assisted living centers **and** home health agencies licensed by the State Department of Health to complete, at a minimum, one (1) hour of in-service training per year in Alzheimer's and dementia-related care.

1       B. The curricula for the training shall include, but not be  
2 limited to, learning ways to decode behavior messages, identifying  
3 common behavioral triggers and determining the types of positive  
4 communication that can take place between persons with Alzheimer's  
5 disease and professional caregivers.

6       C. The Board shall also promulgate rules establishing  
7 appropriate training requirements for support staff working in the  
8 facilities listed in subsection A of this section who do not provide  
9 direct care for patients.

10       SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
