If the execution of the sentence of death as provided in subsections A, B and C of this section is held unconstitutional by 10 11 an appellate court of competent jurisdiction or is otherwise 12 unavailable, then the sentence of death shall be carried out by 13 firing; 3. Firing squad; or 14 15 4. When the above methods are unavailable, any method not 16 prohibited by the United States Constitution. The manner of carrying out the punishment of death shall be 17 selected by the Director of the Department of Corrections. Notice 18 of the selected manner of carrying out the punishment shall be given 19 to the convicted inmate as provided by policy of the Department of 20 21 Corrections. SECTION 2.
