17	furnished a camera by the Department of Public Safety without charge

19	1. Based upon the number of driver licenses issued during the
20	preceding year, the total number of licenses issued shall average
21	not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) per year per camera
22	within the municipality and not less than one thousand two hundred
23	(1,200) per year per camera within the county; <del>provided,</del> <u>or</u>

1	2. The motor license agent is located in a municipality with a
2	population greater than five hundred (500) and the municipality is
3	located fifteen (15) miles or more from any other motor license
4	agency.
5	B. In addition to the provisions of subsection A of this
6	section, each county shall have at least one motor license agent who
7	shall be furnished a camera.
8	B. C. For the purposes of this section, each motor license
9	agent appointed after July 1, 2002, shall be considered a new agent,
10	whether assets of another agency were inherited, purchased or
11	otherwise acquired.
12	$\frac{C.}{D.}$ The furnishing of any camera shall be subject to
13	availability from the vendor and, if limited, shall be allocated
14	according to this section.
