13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:	
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2011, Section 967, is	
15	amended to read as follows:	
16	Section 967. A. The Corporation Commission is hereby	
17	authorized to assess a fee upon each wrecker or towing service	
18	licensed by the Department of Public Safety and placed upon an	
19	official rotation log, as specified in Section 952 of Title 47 of	
20	the Oklahoma Statutes, to perform nonconsensual tows.	
21	B. Each wrecker or towing service shall pay the assessment,	
22	levied pursuant to this section, on an annual basis.

C. The assessment shall be predicated upon the number of wrecker or towing vehicles utilized by the wrecker or towing service to conduct its Department-licensed operations.

- D. Commencing with assessments made after June 30, 2017,
 failing to pay the wrecker or towing services assessment by the due
 date established by the Corporation Commission shall result in an
 additional penalty of twenty-five percent (25%) per vehicle. The
 Transportation Division Director, or designee, may waive the penalty
 for good cause shown. Failure to pay the assessment in a timely
 manner and penalty within thirty (30) days of the notice of penalty
 issued by the Corporation Commission shall result in revocation of
 the wrecker or towing license issued by the Department.
- E. Beginning fiscal year 2013, the Legislature shall establish budgetary limits for the Commission to fulfill the duties of the Nonconsensual Towing Act of 2011. The total assessments levied pursuant to this section shall not exceed the amount of the budgetary limits and indirect costs for related support functions established by the Legislature for any fiscal year. For fiscal year 2012, the total assessments shall not exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00) Annual budgetary limits shall stay in effect unless superseded by action of the Legislature.
 - SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.
