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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-319, as
17	amended by Section 1, Chapter 63, O.S.L. 2013 (63 O.S. Supp. 2016,
18	Section 1-319), is amended to read as follows:
19	Section 1-319. A. A burial transit permit issued under the
20	laws of another state which accompanies a dead body or fetus brought
21	into this state shall be authority for final disposition of the body
22	or fetus in this state.
23	B. A <u>disinterment</u> permit for disinterment and reinterment shall
24	be required prior to disinterment of a dead body or fetus except as

- 1 authorized by regulation or otherwise provided by law. Such permit
- 2 shall be issued by the State Registrar of Vital Records to a
- 3 licensed funeral director, embalmer, or other person acting as such,
- 4 upon proper application.
- 5 | C. Application for a disinterment shall include proof of notice
- 6 to the owner(s) of the interment lot or burial space, if other than
- 7 the applicant the consent of the next of kin. The consent of the
- 8 next of kin shall be completed by the next of kin in order of
- 9 priority as established in Section 1158 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma
- 10 Statutes.
- 11 D. Application for disinterment shall include proof of notice
- 12 to all surviving adult children of the decedent, if other than the
- 13 applicant If the dead body or fetus is to be disinterred and
- 14 | reinterred in the same cemetery, a disinterment permit is not
- 15 required.
- 16 E. If the dead body or fetus is to be disinterred and
- 17 reinterred in the same cemetery, a notice of disinterment and
- 18 reinterment shall be completed, signed by the funeral director and
- 19 the next of kin, and then submitted to the State Registrar of Vital
- 20 Records at the State Department of Health within five (5) days of
- 21 such action.
- 22 F. The forms for the Disinterment Permit and Notice of
- 23 Disinterment and Reinterment shall be obtained from the State
- 24 | Registrar of Vital Records.
