22	pursuant to Section 3-101 of Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statutes and
23	request that any guardianship order take effect immediately on the
24	minor's eighteenth birthday.

1	B. The petitioner may provide with the petition a copy of the
2	results of an evaluation of the minor by a physician, psychologist
3	or other appropriate professional evaluation that meets the
4	requirements of subsection C of Section 3-101 of Title 30 of the
5	Oklahoma Statutes. If the evaluation was conducted within sixty
6	(60) days prior to the filing of the petition, the petitioner may
7	ask in the petition that the court accept this report in lieu of
8	ordering any additional evaluation pursuant to Section 3-108 of
9	Title 30 of the Oklahoma Statues, and the court may grant the
10	request.
