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9	An Act relating to organ donation and procurement;
10	amending 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2151.1, which relates to certain restrictions; permitting procurement of
11	certain specimens under certain circumstances; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.
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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 2151.1, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 2151.1 No human sperm, tissue or organ reproductive
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17	tissue(s) shall be procured for donation purposes from any person
18	testing positive for the human immunodeficiency virus (HIV)
19	infection. Organ(s) and tissue(s) may be procured for donation
20	purposes from any person testing positive for HIV infection,
21	provided such procurement and donation are consistent with the HIV
22	Organ Policy Equity (HOPE) Act (P.L. 113-51, 127 Stat. 579 (2013))
23	and the regulations promulgated thereunder by the Organ Procurement
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1	and Transplantation Network and the United States Food and Drug
2	Administration.
3	1. Every donor, donor candidate or tissue <u>tissue(s)</u> or organ
4	organ(s) to be donated shall be tested for said the virus infection
5	immediately prior to the donation of sperm, reproductive tissue(s)
6	or tissues <u>tissue(s)</u> or organs <u>organ(s)</u> for transplant. If such
7	test has not been conducted immediately prior to the donation, then
8	the test shall be conducted immediately prior to the implantation of
9	the donor organ <u>organ(s)</u> or tissue <u>tissue(s)</u> .
10	2. If the donor is living, the donor shall be notified of the
11	test results. Notification shall be consistent with donor
12	confidentiality and with the requirements of state and federal law.
13	The hospital or other facility responsible for the sperm
14	reproductive tissue, tissue or organ donation shall provide directly
15	or otherwise make available appropriate information and counseling
16	services to sperm <u>reproductive tissue</u> donors and to living tissue or
17	organ donors.
18	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
